## Jacobs wins Open BAM

It's different in 2002, and George Jacobs and Co. are very happy about it. A year ago they lost the Open Board-a-Match Teams by less than one-hundredth of a board. Last night they finished three and a half boards ahead of the field

Playing with Jacobs were Ralph Katz and Italians Norberto Bocchi, Giorgio Duboin, Alfredo Versace and Lorenzo Lauria. The runners-up were Roy Welland, Bjorn Fallenius, Brad Moss, Howard Weinstein, Steve Garner and Fred Gitelman. Only a third of a board behind them were George Rosenkranz, Eddie Wold, Geir Helgemo of Norway, and Piotr Gawrys and Jacek Pzszcola of Poland.

In the past Jacobs has tried psyching Exclusion Blackwood with a notable lack of success. Katz credits last night's victory to the fact that Exclusion Blackwood didn't come up. "Of course it didn't," said Jacobs. "No hand came up that met my standards for Exclusion Blackwood."

One session when the four Italians were playing, they racked up 20.5 points. "That was so much fun," said Jacobs.

Her son Alan, the last speaker, told the crowd, "All of you are a part of her extended family." Then he added with a twinkle, "But you're not in her will."

Several of the folks with whom Aileen has been close over the years spoke of their affection and admiration of Aileen. Henry Francis, Daily Bulletin editor, told how Aileen had started from scratch and made goodwill work. Barbara Nudelman, former ACBL president, called Aileen "the hostess with the mostest" who has made the bridge world a better place. Joan Gerard, also a former president, presented an 18-carat gold Goodwill

players have come to appreciate his efforts to make their lives at and away from the bridge table more satisfying and pleasurable."

National Tournament Director Roger Putnam added, "Bill is the hardest working and nicest person you'll ever meet."

Matt Smith, a National Tournament Director, said it this way: "Bill Breeze is probably the most tireless volunteer I have ever encountered. He will do absolutely whatever is necessary to ensure the success of a tournament, and he does it all without complaint and without even being asked. He is also a man of unmatched character, integrity and generosity."

Actually Breeze offers his efforts to two bridge organizations – the ACBL and the American Bridge Association. He is currently president of the LeEtta King Bridge Club of the Seattle/Tacoma Unit of the Northwestern Section of the ABA. He has served three terms as president of ACBL Unit 446.

ABA officials also rate Breeze right at the top. Edward West, national chair of the ABA/ACBL Liaison Committee put it this way: "Bill is highly respected by the members of the Northwestern Section for his hard work, diligence and participation. He consistently volunteers to perform tasks for many of the functions of the clubs, unit and section."

Terry Randles, owner of the Eastside Bridge Club in Redmond WA, says, "If it had not been for Bill Breeze we might not have had a bridge club. He supported us in every way, being right there with us through thick and thin."

The general feeling is that Bill is always doing something for somebody, which certainly qualifies him magnificently for our Goodwill Member of the Year.

George Rosenkranz, one of the co-chairmen of the Goodwill Committee, was extremely impressed by another letter received concerning the Goodwill Member. Unit 425 of the Anchorage AK Bridge Center nominated its collective membership, represented by Unit President Chris Ward.

Here's the background.

In August 2001 Darlene Enbysk, one of the major owners of a club in Anchorage, died. Her husband Howard did not have the heart to continue and announced his plans to disband if no one stepped forward to buy the club. No one bought the club.

However, in May the board wrote to its members, asking them to help if the unit took over the club. The response was tremendous! Doug Scott, Della Palmer and Kathy Centoni agreed to direct. One game was dropped, but Ruth Pease came forward to direct it. Wonnie Duncan began calling people and built up another of the games. Directors began monitoring prospective directors and four have now taken the director's test. Seven others will take the test soon.

Shannon Jones has just chaired a highly successful regional. Janice Tingler organized a Tax Relief Sunday. Della Palmer organized a May Day luncheon and bridge game. Duff Pfanner chaired a barbeque and game. Phil Morrow started a snack concession. Susan and David Drigger manned a membership drive.

All in all, it has been a wonderful cooperative effort. But the Goodwill Member award of course has to go to a member, not a large group.

## Why 4-4 fits play so well

The advantage of playing in a 4-4 fit was perfectly demonstrated on this deal from the second qualifying session of the Board-a-Match Teams.

Mark Horton's 2♣ bid was inverted. When Leonard Helman showed diamond values, Horton jumped to 4♥ to initiate a cuebidding sequence. When it came time to set the final contract, Horton went for diamonds. He was quite sure that partner had five clubs and four diamonds.

His decision paid off. The long club allowed Helman to get rid of his losing heart. If the final contract had been 6♣, there would have no parking place for that losing heart.

## Enormous problems

In my section of the first qualifying session of the Open Board-a-Match Teams, board 22 presented enormous problems.

The auction: 1♦-4♠-Dbl-All Pass was very common.

North led the ♦5, playing third- and fifth-best leads, and South won the ♦K and returned his trump. Declarer can, of course, make 10 tricks by rising with the ♠A and playing on clubs, but finessing seemed a reasonable play.

If North wins his ♠K, he now has to decide how to cash out. If he returns the ♦4, he gives South the problem of how to cash out – could partner have a doubleton diamond? Could declarer be 8-3-2-0?

The answer is that North should play the ♦Q and wait for South to give count on the diamonds. If South shows a remaining odd number, North cashes the ♥A. Otherwise, he plays a third diamond.

## No Chicken Alfredo

Alfredo Versace and George Jacobs played this hand from the second qualifying session of the Life Master Pairs, but Alfredo was the chef who mixed the ingredients just right for a tasty game.

When the dummy came down after the ♥7 opening lead, Versace saw that he had eight tricks – if the club finesse worked. That meant he had to score six tricks with his trump suit. North took the ♥Q with the ace and got out with a heart to the king. Alfredo called for the ♦K, won by South and he continued with a second diamond to the queen. Declarer went to the board with the trump king and took a successful club finesse. After cashing the ♣A, he led a spade to the ace.

Now he was ready. He ruffed a diamond in hand and a club in dummy. Next he led a heart and ruffed it with the queen – he was sure South had started with a doubleton heart. He now had nine tricks in – two spades, two clubs, one heart, one diamond and three ruffs. In the two-card ending, South had the master trump but the dummy still had the trump 8. Versace led a club from his hand and scored dummy's last trump en passant for his game.

There are all sorts of ways to make nine tricks in hearts on this deal from the first qualifying session of the Open Board-a-Match Teams. Mine may not have been the best, but it did produce an elegant ending.

We might have become much richer defending 3♦ doubled but 3♥ on a club lead saw me (West) decide to win the ♣A and play the ♥A and a second heart. North won and cashed a third heart, then exited with the ♦J. I won the ♦A and ducked a spade. Back came a second diamond, and I won the ace and reached this ending:

When I ruffed a spade in dummy, South was squeezed. If he pitched a club, I could duck a club and pitch my spade loser on the clubs in due course.

When he chose to pitch a diamond, I could ruff a diamond to hand and pass the ♣9 to South, who was employed in the two-card position.

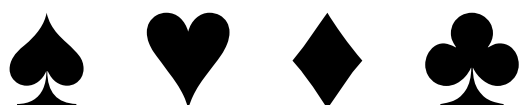

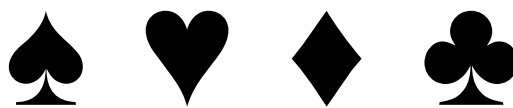
