Deas, Kennedy first in Women's Pairs

Two giants from the world of women's bridge teamed up to grab the Smith Life Master Women's Pairs title. Lynn Deas and Betty Ann Kennedy posted a 64.95% effort in the first final session with a huge 71.28% game in the second final to win the four-session event by more than three boards. Their final score with carryover was 11118.08.

The duo was in 49th place after Friday's qualifying round.

Kennedy dedicated the win to her late husband, Jack, who died three months ago.

"He would have been so pleased," said Kennedy of her late spouse. The couple was married 46 years.

Although Deas and Kennedy have multiple national and world titles to their credit, this is the first time they have ever won together as a partnership. Their previous outing in as a

partnership in this event two years ago resulted in a fourth-place finish.

In second place, with 1015.11 (top = 31), were Floridians Janice Seamon-Molson and Gigi Weinstein.

Demirev, Katz win Nail LM Open Pairs

Nikolay Demirev and Ralph Katz rebounded from a miserable start in the second final session of the Nail Life Master Open Pairs to win by less than half a board.

Second place went to Eric Rodwell and John Diamond.

The winners, both from the Chicago area, led the field by a board and a half after the first final session but did not start well in the evening.

"After seven rounds," said Katz, "we were at least two boards below average. They were killing us."

They hung in there, however, and the tide turned. Said Katz, "When the opponents started making mistakes, we took advantage." Their session ended up at 56.15%, and their final score was

Young players get two divisions

The ACBL Board of Directors has approved a realignment for young players with the creation of Youth and Junior divisions.

Youth players are defined as those 19 and younger. The Junior division will be for players 25 and younger.



The change was announced at Saturday's Junior reception by Patty Tucker, ACBL's youth coordinator.

Tucker said the split was made to that the different needs of the two age groups could be addressed. She invited the young players in attendance at the reception to join steering committees to help formulate policy.

She said she could not guarantee that every suggestion would be acted upon, "but everything you bring to our attention will be looked at."

Top seeds cruise in Senior Knockouts

In yesterday's Round-of-32 action in the Senior Knockouts, the top seeds were in top form, winning each of their respective matches, with two exceptions.

The No. 10 seed led by Farid Assemi lost to Ken Cohen's No. 23 seed, 140-98. Playing with Cohen are Neal Satten, Rick Rowland and Richard Popper.

Also, the No. 15 seed captained by Jan Martel fell to the No. 18 seed with Jim Sternberg at the helm. Sternberg's lineup includes John Solodar,

Claude Vogel, Sangarapil Mohan, Robert Gardner and Craig Gardner. Sternberg won 189-105.

The defending champions, captained by Robert Hollman, had an easy time with a Canadian foursome led by Paul Sorensen, winning 176-65. In today's round of 16, they will play the team led by Ron Smith of the Chattanooga TN area. Hollman is playing with Bruce Ferguson, Brenda Keller, Marc Jacobus and Dennis and Jerry Clerkin.

1st World Youth Bridge Championships

The first World Youth Bridge Championships are scheduled for Istanbul, Turkey, next summer and will be open to all players born on or after Jan. 1, 1984.

The tournament will take place Aug. 15-23 at Yeditepe University and will feature Swiss and knockout teams, board-a-match teams, matchpoint pairs and IMP pairs. Entry fees are 500 euros per team and 200 euros per pair.

The events are transnational with no quotas for countries. Full board accommodations are available in double rooms at 45 euros per person per day.

Matchpoint strategy

Bid aggressively. Duplicate pairs tend to bid “close” games and slams, so don’t settle for a safe part score if you think there’s a fair chance you can make game.

Choose the highest-scoring game. For game contracts, you should be most anxious to play 4♥ or 4♠, willing to play 3NT and reluctant to play 5♣ or 5♦. If you have game values and a club or diamond fit, consider playing 3NT instead.



Choose the safest part score. When you have minimum high-card strength, choose the safety of a trump suit. A major suit is still best, but if you’re deciding between notrump and a minor, play a suit contract if you have a fit and you’re in a part score.

Overall freely. Don’t be afraid to make light, lead-directing overcalls at the one-level – especially when you’re not vulnerable and your opponent opens 1♣ or 1♦. If you have to go to the two level to bid your suit, though, be somewhat cautious. For a two-level overcall, you should have a good suit – a strong five-carder or, better, a suit of six or more cards, especially if you’re vulnerable.

Raise partner’s suit freely. Even if you’re light in high-card points, stretch to raise partner if you have a fit for his suit, especially in competitive auctions.

Sacrifice more often. If you have a good fit, sacrifice freely if your opponents are vulnerable and you are not. Be very conservative when you’re vulnerable.

Don’t “sell out” too low. If the opponents stop at a low level, you don’t have to have a strong hand to balance back in. The best time to compete is when: (1) You’re not vulnerable, (2) the opponents have stopped in one or two of a suit contract (not 1NT or 2NT) and (3) you’re short in the opponents’ trump suit.

One of my early mentors, Sandy Drum, had a rule, “Nobody plays 2♥ unless I have hearts.” Basically, this means balancing if the opponents stop in 2♥ with a double or overcalling a five-card suit (preferably spades).

Double more part scores. If you bid to a part

score you think you could have made and your opponents bid over it, a double is sometimes necessary for you to get even an average score (be very careful in choosing when to use this tip).

Use a simplified form of the law of total tricks for competitive decisions. If your side has hearts, bid 3♥ over their 2♠, but hesitate to bid 3♠ over their 3♥ without a nine-card trump fit. If this doesn’t work out, send Larry Cohen a note.

In the play, make normal opening leads. Don’t try for a top by choosing an unusual lead. Against most contracts, choose a safe, non-deceptive opening lead.

Look for overtricks. Unlike in rubber bridge, it’s sometimes right to make a risky play trying for the overtrick – especially when you’re in a normal contract that you think will be bid by other pairs.

Play it safe if you’re in an unusual contract. Go for the sure plus score if you’re playing or defending a contract that won’t be bid at most tables.

Fight for every trick. Don’t claim with an obvious loser. Play all your winners out. The defenders may go wrong and make a mistake in their discards. Besides, torturing the opposition is one of the two reasons I play bridge (torturing my partner is the other).

You must defend very well, fight for every

single trick. It’s the difference between winning and losing. You aren’t necessarily trying to beat the declarer at all times, just everybody else sitting in the same direction.

Taking your tops and trying to go average the rest of the time is the formula for success.

Counting their tricks

Opening lead: ♦3.

Bidding commentary: As North, your 2♥ weak jump overcall is akin to a weak two-bid. It shows a six-card suit, typically headed by two or three honors, 6-9 high-card points. South's raise to 4♥ is a bit aggressive. A "scientific" option is to make a forcing 2NT response, asking partner to further describe the hand. This response would elicit 3♥ from North, showing a minimum. With a better hand, North would show a side-suit feature, an ace or a king. As South, you should pass 3♥, but that is water over the dam. West's double of 4♥ is for takeout, showing short hearts and a strong hand. As East, do not remove a takeout double of a game contract with a weak balanced hand.

Lead commentary: As East holding three or four low cards in partner's suit, lead low if you have not supported, high if you have. As an aside, with the ace in partner's suit, lead the ace – period. The lead of an ace in partner's suit denies the king.

Defensive commentary: As West, after you



take your two diamond tricks, count their tricks. The bidding tells you of six heart tricks, and once North drives out the ♣A, declarer will have established three club tricks to go along with the ♠A for 10 tricks. What can you do? Your only hope is to build up a

quick spade trick before your ♣A is removed. Play partner for the ♠Q and shift to a low spade at trick three. If you do, partner comes through and plays the ♠Q, driving out the ace. The ♠K is the setting trick.

Bridge players needed for university study

You are invited to participate in a Harvard University research study in conjunction with the Boston NABC. The study, which takes approximately 15 minutes, involves taking a bridge quiz designed by famed bridge expert Michael Rosenberg, two-time ACBL Player of the Year, winner of 14 North American Championships and World Grand Master.

Multiple prizes of \$250 or better will be awarded in different masterpoint categories, plus additional winners selected at random.

The study will be conducted at the Westin on Tuesday, Nov. 25, immediately outside the America Ballroom on the fourth floor. Two tables and large posters will identify the experiment location. Interested players may participate from 11:45 a.m. until 12:45 p.m. (15 minutes before game time), or immediately after the afternoon session, or from 6:15 till 7:15 p.m. (15 minutes before evening game time).

Participants will also be asked to provide a sample of genetic material through a mouthwash sample. The general hypothesis of the research is that some genetic markers correlate with bridge bidding propensities. All responses, include

mouthwash samples, will be recorded anonymously.

Once the study is completed on Wednesday, the answers to the quiz will be distributed, as well as a detailed explanation of the study's purpose. All results from the study will be reported on an aggregate basis, e.g., players with fewer than 200 masterpoints tended to bid 3NT on a particular hand. Final results from the study will be posted on a public website, and submitted to a major bridge publication.

This study is overseen by Richard Zeckhauser, the Frank Plumpton Ramsey Professor of Political Economy at Harvard University.

3109.77. Rodwell and Diamond had 3030.59. Top was 90.

Demirev arrived in the U.S. from Bulgaria eight years ago. He now earns a living teaching English as a second language and playing bridge. He said a key to his success as a player has been the support of his wife, Darina.

He and Katz are infrequent partners, but they did play in the Silodor Open Pairs earlier this year in Detroit. Demirev was winning his second North American championship. He and Jiang Gu won the IMP Pairs in 2004.

Katz, with many North American titles, was highly complimentary of Demirev. "He played great," said Katz.

Make your partner feel good

We all like to win at bridge, don't we? An exception was my late brother-in-law. He was the most adorable person I ever met at the bridge table. Hilbert was delighted to let his opponents win.

But to how to become a winner then? In my humble opinion, it starts and ends by assisting your partner's state of mind. In other words, make your partner feel good. Just find out what he/she thinks is important in bridge and adjust yourself to her or his preferences. If you are able to do that, you will soon find out that your partnership will have a massive boost.

Here in Boston I am happy to play the Senior Knockout Teams, partnering David Kendrick. He is every inch an Englishman: four-card suits, standard carding, hardly any conventions. In other words, he likes to keep things simple – e.g., fourth suit is game forcing, even at the one level. Or when you are on lead against a suit contract and your choice is between leading from ace and king or a singleton, kick off with the latter. All this saves your partner's energy, since it keeps him from thinking, wondering and remembering.

Before our tourney started, David specifically requested me not to lead his suit, unless I had a good reason for it. Keeping that in mind, let's have a look at a hand from the Senior KO, round one.

Declarer took the lead of the ♠8 with her queen and returned a club for the jack and king. A spade came back for the ace and declarer continued a club for the 10. Dummy's ♠J went to the king and David returned the suit. East's bidding very much suggested he possessed the ♥K as an entry for his fifth spade. By the way, both South and West had got rid of two low hearts on the third and fourth round of spades.

At this point declarer had eight certain tricks. She first cashed out in diamonds. When that didn't work, she fell back on the heart finesse. Down one, as this was the full lay out:

On the run of the spades, West was squeezed and obliged to reduce down to one heart. If declarer cashed the ♥A, West can be endplayed in diamonds and will have to give the ninth trick in clubs. Alternatively, declarer could cash ♦A and another diamond honor and then play a club. Coming in with the ♣K, East could have broken up the squeeze by returning a diamond. Extremely difficult to foresee that, I would say.

Final words for David: "It's almost always wrong to lead my suit. Just lead hearts."

Our teammates passed out the deal. North didn't like his ugly 12 count and passed. And South didn't like his hand, either. But that had merely to do with the fact that he thought he had only 11 HCP.

Marsha May Sternberg Women's B-A-M

Play in the Marsha May Sternberg Women's Board-a-Match Teams gets underway today, with two qualifying sessions followed by two final sessions tomorrow.

At stake: the Marsha Sternberg Memorial Trophy, honoring the player who died in 2001 after a six-week battle with cancer.

Her husband, Dr. Jim Sternberg of West Palm Beach FL, donated the trophy.

The winners of the 2007 contest were Ping Wang, Shaohong Wu, Jian Wang, Yongmei Zhou of China.

Marsha Sternberg was a former *National Enquirer* associate editor and the first female writer for the tabloid. Sternberg, once reported to be the highest paid female journalist in America, left the *Enquirer* in 1989 and married Dr. Sternberg, a radiologist and bridge enthusiast. She joined ACBL in 1990 and became a Life Master in 1997.

Sternberg was outstanding in many fields — she was an excellent pianist and a sailing instructor. She was also very successful in gold and tennis.

Coffin Trophy

The previous trophy for this event was the Coffin Trophy, one of the oldest and most historic trophies in NABC competition. It was retired.

For years there was only one "National" Women's Team championship — and that was a board-a-match event.

Donated by Charles Emmet Coffin in 1933, the trophy was contested at the "Winter Nationals" in the days when there were only two NABCs — Summer and Winter. In 1963 the event was moved to the new Spring NABC where it was in play until the format was changed to knockout teams in 1976.

For the next decade, there was no national Women's Board-a-Match championship. Swiss teams had become popular and a Women's Swiss with NABC+ rating was established in the early Eighties. But board-a-match play for women was not dead — it was just in hiatus for a few years.

The Coffin Trophy was revived at the Fall NABC in Atlanta in 1986 and new life was breathed into women's board-a-match play.

Many experts consider board-a-match the most exacting form of the game. Equal weight is accorded each deal and every trick is important when scoring is board-by-board.

Open BAM begins today

Aubrey Strul captured his first North American championship at the 2007 NABC in San Francisco when his squad won the Mitchell Open Board-a-Match Teams by almost three boards. Strul, playing with Michael Becker, David Berkowitz, Larry Cohen, Lew Stansby and Chip Martel, posted 17 wins in the first final session and 20 in the second final. With carryover, their total was 39.73.

In second with 36.83 was the Russian Polish team of Andrew Gromov (captain), Aleksander Dubinin, Cezary Balicki and Adam Zmudzinski. The Gromov team won the qualifying round on the first day of the contest, and maintained their lead after the first final session. The Strul team, however, was already making their move, trailing Gromov in second place. Strul's strong performance in the second final allowed them to overtake the leaders and cruise to the win.

The Mitchell Trophy

Players will be competing for the Victor Mitchell Trophy, which honors one of bridge's most colorful characters -- a champion player, philosopher and mentor to the stars.

Mitchell, a Grand Life Master with more than 10,000 masterpoints, won five North American championships including the Spingold in 1956 and 1959, the Life Master Men's Pairs in 1962 and the Men's Teams in 1962 and 1963. He was named ACBL Honorary Member in 1988 and inducted into the Bridge Hall of Fame in 1996.

The game

The Open Board-a-Match Teams is a four-session event that consists of two qualifying and two final sessions. It was a men's event until 1990 when it became an open event.

Perhaps the event's high point occurred in 1977 when there were only three winners: Richard Doughty, Ron Smith and Lou Bluhm (plus these players eligible for session awards only: Bruce Ferguson, Sidney Lazard, Leslie West and Irv Kostal).

Lazard was supposed to play with Doughty but after a good first set, Lazard became ill and Kostal took his place for the evening session.

Lazard was better the next day and in his seat for the first final session. Suddenly he toppled over and a call went out for paramedics. They arrived quickly and rushed Lazard to a hospital.

Meanwhile, Doughty had to find another partner and Ferguson was pressed into service. Ferguson, whose team had not qualified the previous day, was technically ineligible but was allowed to play only in the afternoon.

In the evening, Doughty recruited West -- his fourth partner in four sessions -- and the team went on to victory by a margin of two full boards.

I won't try to grow vegetables if they refrain from building computers." He also promulgated Kotok's Rule for apportioning blame
