

Milner clobbers Nickell for Vanderbilt victory

Reese Milner's first North American championship almost didn't happen. In fact, four members of his team were signed up to play with George Rosenkranz. When Rosenkranz canceled his plans to attend the Spring NABC, Milner inherited the squad and added Marc Jacobus as his partner.

The move paid off in a big way as Milner, Jacobus, Sam Lev, John Mohan, Jacek Pszczola and Piotr Gawrys hammered the Nick Nickell team in the Vanderbilt final, 199-115.

The runners-up are Nickell, Richard Freeman, Jeff Meckstroth, Eric Rodwell, Bob Hamman and Paul Soloway.

Milner is a real estate investor who lives in Beverly Hills CA. He started playing "serious" bridge about five years ago at the urging of Fred Gitelman. Since then Milner has played with Robert Levin and Jacobus. At the World Championships in Bermuda two years ago, Milner, Jacobus, Levin, Gitelman and Brad Moss were second in the Transnational Open Teams.



Kahn ducked the lead of the $\clubsuit Q$ and won the next club to try to find a lie of the cards that would allow him to make. He decided he needed the $\bigstar A$ -Q right. If West had the $\bigstar A$ and $\blacklozenge J$, that did not leave room for the $\blacktriangledown Q$. So he played a heart to the 10, the $\bigstar 9$ to the queen and king, a heart to the 9, the $\blacktriangledown A$, a spade to the 10, the $\bigstar K$, and finally a third spade. If West cashed the $\bigstar A$, dummy's $\bigstar K$ would be the eighth winner and the fifth spade would represent the ninth trick, and a club play would make life easy. So West played a diamond. Kahn hopped up with the king and exited with a diamond in this ending, with declarer having eight tricks in the bag:

Declarer won the opening riangle Q lead with dummy's ace and led a diamond to the queen – Rodwell ducked smoothly! Chris looked carefully at the full hand and decided that if Meckstroth had the riangle A without the jack he might have hopped up with the ace to play spades through in case declarer had eight tricks. So before playing a diamond up he crossed to the ildes Q and ran the riangle 10 successfully. He repeated the club finesse, tested the hearts and reduced to this ending:

West leads the $\mathbf{\Psi}Q$. Trumps are 2–1, East having a low singleton. Plan the play.

Kantar's answer: West's opening lead marks East with the $\forall K$, and West's non-spade lead marks East with some spade honors. West, therefore, should have the $\clubsuit K$, no? Yes.

Best play is to ruff the opening lead, draw two rounds of trump ending in your hand, and lead a club to the 10. If this loses to the king you make 11 or 12 tricks. Assuming it loses to the jack and a spade comes back, win (or duck and win the spade return) and enter dummy with the \clubsuit A. If the king falls, that's all she wrote. If it doesn't, the \clubsuit Q is discarded on the \P A and a club ruffed in the closed hand gives you one more chance — 3–3 clubs.

Given that West should have the $\clubsuit K$, this line of play works anytime West has both the $\clubsuit K$ and the $\clubsuit J$, the doubleton $\clubsuit K$ or clubs are 3–3. Good enough?

Defending to the max

While we were waiting to interview G.S. Jade Barrett on the occasion of his going over 10,000 points, we watched Nina Reich of Orange County CA and Louise Kavall of Las Vegas defend Barrett's contract to the maximum.

Kavall got off to a heart lead to partner's king, and Reich switched to her singleton spade. Barrett rose with the ace and immediately finessed the ♠10. When North showed out, he knew he had to lose a trump. Since he also had three red-suit losers he decided to try to eliminate one of them. He called for a heart, and Reich rose with the ace. She studied long and hard at this point. She didn't want to lead the ♦A and set up dummy's kingqueen, so she tried a club and was happy when partner was able to ruff. Kavall shot back a diamond and Reich gave her a second club ruff for plus 200 and just about all the matchpoints.

When East played the queen, West could duck in which case East would have to concede a trick to the \clubsuit A. But if West overtakes, he has to give up declarer's ninth trick to the \blacklozenge 10. Sticking to his original game plan, Chris cashed his club on which West pitched a spade. He led a diamond to the king and exited with a diamond to endplay Rodwell for plus 430.

Note that if Rodwell takes the first diamond to clear spades, declarer will cash the $\diamond K$ before taking the club finesse. If West plays anything but a spade back at trick three, declarer will make the avoidance play in diamonds on the second round by taking the $\diamond K$ and playing a third round of the suit.



3 doubled goes down only three tricks, but $4 \forall$ was no picnic! On the $\triangle Q$ lead to dummy's ace, Garber guessed well to pass the $\forall 10$ to North. Back came the $\triangle J$, ruffed high and overruffed. South now exited with a third heart, leaving this position:



There are two elegant ways to make the hand. One (anti-percentage admittedly) is to play three rounds of diamonds, ruffing in hand and lead the $\clubsuit Q$ to endplay South. Garber found a far better approach, leading the $\blacklozenge 7$ and covering North's 8 with the 10! South won and had to give declarer a cheap club trick or return a diamond, giving Garber the extra entry to ruff out the suit for 10 tricks.

NAOP Flight B began in grass roots

Competition begins today in the North American Open Pairs Flight B, a grassroots event limited to players with 0-1500 masterpoints.

The first stage is conducted at the local club level and qualifiers advance to unit competition. Those qualifiers then advance to the district finals where three pairs -- more, depending upon attendance -- qualify for the North American final.

Winners will have their names inscribed on the Golder Cup and will also receive a certificate of recognition.

The trophy is presented in memory of Benjamin M. Golder (1894-1946) of Philadelphia, who died the day before the close of his term as 1946 ACBL president. He was named ACBL *Honorary Member of the Year* for 1947.

Bill Anderson Day

The following is a letter written by Dianna and Joe Gittelman and their family about Dianna's father, Bill Anderson, whose memory is being honored today.

About nine months ago, Carolyne Fox called me to tell me she would like to honor my father, Bill Anderson, at the Houston NABC. At the time I was so taken I could hardly breathe. I was not aware that Carolyne and George knew my Dad that well. She told about some wonderful times they had with him pertaining to bridge and some other times when Dad and some other bridge friends would go to hear their son in a band.

Dad loved bridge more than life. In a tense moment, he always had a cute story if it was the opponents. But if he and his partner didn't agree, he would say, "Oh, get out of here!" You would always see him shaking his right leg (a habit), but when he was thinking he would tap his right four fingers on the table. Some people look up or down for the answer, but Dad seemed to get his answers from tapping on the table. He always played the game with a spirit to win but never at the risk of an unfair circumstance. To me he was a true champion!

Here's a story about my Dad. When I was nine years old, we moved to a new house. Mom and Dad couldn't wait to have their favorite bridge friends over for a team game. We still had boxes everywhere, but Dad moved them to the garage and the game began. My sisters and I were in bed when I heard Mom telling me to come with her - we needed to get out of the house. All of a sudden fire engines were at the house – the garage was on fire! The day before we had had a fire in our fireplace, and when Dad cleaned out the fireplace he put the ashes in a metal container with a paper top in the garage! I was 9, sister Mary was 6 and sister Christi was 4, and we were scared to death! It didn't take long to put out the fire, but we were very afraid. Dad and Mom consoled us, gave us hugs and resumed the bridge game.

I have found out that Dad was more than a bridge partner to many people. He was a real good friend to some and a best friend to others. He was my best friend and always my favorite bridge partner.

Righteous Rabbi

He may or may not be a religious person, but he certainly knows his way around a card table, as you can see from this deal, played Thursday in a regional pairs event. North started with the \clubsuit K, taken by Helman with the ace. He played a diamond to dummy's king and continued with the \blacklozenge Q, knocking out the ace. North could have given Helman a lot of trouble by shifting to a spade, but he continued with the \clubsuit Q and a third round of clubs.

Helman won in dummy and floated the $\mathbf{\Psi}Q$. He then cashed the $\mathbf{\Phi}J$, felling South's 10, and entered his hand with the $\mathbf{\Phi}9$. The $\mathbf{\Psi}A$ and $\mathbf{\Psi}J$ were next, and South found himself on lead with nothing but spades.

South played the $\bigstar K$, but Helman ducked, leaving South on lead at trick 12 to play into dummy's spade tenace. Plus 600 was worth nearly all the matchpoints.

NAOP-C Pairs compete for President's Cup

Players in the North American Open Pairs Flight C, a grassroots event limited to players who have not yet become Life Masters, will begin competition today for the President's Cup.

The trophy was presented in 1942 by Morgan Howard, ACBL president that year. The trophy was previously awarded to the winners of the President's Pairs event, held at the Summer NABC.

The competition began last summer at the local club level and qualifiers then advanced to unit competition. Those qualifiers advanced to the district finals and three pairs from each district -- more, depending upon attendance -- qualified for the North American final.

Many years ago, in a national pairs event at the Spring NABC in Fort Worth, Larry Cohen and Marty Bergen engaged in auction that started with an opening bid on Cohen's left, a takeout double by Bergen and a cuebid by Cohen. Bergen bid something and Cohen cuebid again. Bergen joked, "If you do that again, you might play it."

Joel Wooldridge, reigning Junior world champion, found himself in a similar situation at the Houston NABC in a pair game, but he just kept on cuebidding.

Wooldridge's partner, Dan Zagorin, opened 1♦ and the next player overcalled 2. Wooldridge was looking at

Wooldridge bid 2♥ and partner bid 2NT. Still unsure what to do, Wooldridge bid 3♣, the first cuebid. Zagorin said 34. Aha, thought Wooldridge, this hand is looking up - I think I'll cuebid again. Zagorin, also in a rut, bid 4♠. Undeterred, Wooldridge trotted out his third cuebid. Somewhere, Marty Bergen felt a shiver. In response to 5♣, Zagorin tried spades once more. This was the auction to that point:

masterpoints.

"Anything she does," Gross says of his diminutive partner, "she does seriously."

Anten has done tournament bridge very well, and she credits Gross, an attorney from Westlake Village CA, with helping her game.

Recalling their first meeting, Anten says she was playing at a bridge club with a less-than-ideal partner. In the round against Gross, Anten and her partner had an auction which included a 2NT bid by him and a raise by her to 3NT.

The contract was down five, vulnerable, and in the post mortem Anten was getting the blame for the obvious zero. Gross listened to the abusive partner for a bit, then said, "How good a board do you think 2NT down four was going to be?" From there, Gross took Anten under his wing, and she has blossomed.

Because Gross has more than 11,000 masterpoints, they always had to play in Flight A. Instead of complaining about the stiff competition, she honed her skills and took advantage of the opportunity.

Unaware of who the top players were, Anten didn't know enough to be afraid of anyone, and she has flourished. "She has guts," Gross says.

Anten, a former math teacher from New York, moved to California in 1973 and played "a little" bridge before taking up the game more seriously about six years ago. "At that time in my life," she says, "I needed a challenge."

Since adopting her serious approach to bridge, Anten has missed only one NABC - Vancouver in the spring of 1999 – and that was because she had been involved in a serious automobile accident and was in a wheelchair for three months.

Anten, currently #59 on the 2002 Barry Crane Top 500 list, plans to play in her first world championship this summer in Montreal.

In the meantime, she is enjoying each new day at the bridge table and all that she is learning - "and there's so much more to go."

Here's what happened at one table. Declarer won the club cheaply in hand and took a spade finesse (8-3-10-queen). Back came a devious heart to the jack. Declarer unblocked clubs as South pitched a diamond, then played off the \mathbf{A} with hope in his heart. North ducked of course so declarer played a diamond to North, lost the heart finesse, and won the next heart to play a third diamond

experience."

Milner's teammates are Mohan, a bridge professional now living in the Virgin Islands; Lev, a native of Poland who played for many years for Israel and who has lived in New York City for the past 15 years; Polish stars Gawrys and Pszczola, who answers to the nickname Pepsi Cola, and Jacobus, a professional based in Las Vegas.

Milner was especially complimentary of Lev, who has had considerable success with Mohan. Said Milner: "Lev brings a lot of intensity to the team."

Mohan, Lev, Pszczola and Gawrys teamed with Rosenkranz to finish second in last year's Vanderbilt.

In the 2002 Vanderbilt final, Milner – considered by most to be the underdog – jumped out to a a 55-22 lead in the first quarter and boosted the lead to 78-51 at the halfway point. It got worse for Nickell in the third quarter as Milner's lead grew to 156-83 after a series of major swings.

North-South were JoAnna Stansby and I. East-West? We'll draw a veil over them, but suffice it to say that one of them has very nearly won a world bridge title. Not that the defense did anything awful, though. East led a heart to the king, felling the jack, and West correctly worked out that the defense should cash their diamonds before playing hearts for trump promotions. So West led the \blacklozenge 6. I followed with the 8, and East after some thought put in the 10 - is that so terrible a play if the 6 is the partnership card from 7-6-4?

I drew two rounds of trump and led the $\forall 10$ to the ace. West felt ethically constrained to play another heart even though East really had to have the A for his opening bid. I pitched one diamond as East ruffed with the 8 and then led a club around to my jack. Now I could pitch my last diamond loser on the $\mathbf{\nabla} Q$ and finish up with plus 140.


