King keeps plugging to promote bridge

When it comes to promoting bridge, no one is more ambitious than Larry King, the driving force behind Prize Money Bridge, which kicks off three divisions of play starting today.

Fortunately, no one is more patient than King, who has slowly and steadily shepherded the prize money circuit toward his ultimate goal of a tour with a major sponsor and winnings of up to \$1 million a year for the top performers.

"We are really close to getting a major sponsor," says King, who has put several other business ventures on hold while he works on changing the public's perception of bridge.

For those who doubt it can be done, consider how, with the help of a major sponsor, King elevated the game of tennis from a country club sport with low popularity to a national rage.

Narasimhan, Sprung reach Wagar final

Besides the masterpoints and the prestige of winning, they also receive watches from the Gold Group, whose wares are on sale at the ACBL Product Store.

Second place went to Larry Goldstein of Harrison NY and David Katzman of Greenwich CT, who rallied from 20th place in the standings at the halfway point of the two-session event. The 199er Pairs attracted 42 tables, the largest field ever in the event. The winners, who were in third place with a session to go, met as undergraduates at Brandeis University. New York inexpensive? Yes! Bridge players can stay at the Hilton for the bridge rate, which is much lower than the usual price for hotel rooms in this city. Bridge plus New York plus low room rates – what could be more enticing?

"That's why you see so many Japanese players here," said Miho Sekizawa, secretary of the Japan Contract Bridge League. "I've seen more than 20 of us here so far. We like to go to the American cities we find fascinating – New York, San Francisco, Orlando and Seattle, for instance. You'll see a lot of

The lowest seed still in contention is the original No. 28 (Warren Spector), who took the measure of Jim Mahaffey's No. 12 seed 164-105.

The semifinal and final rounds of the Spingold will be broadcast live on BridgeBase and e-bridge.

Young cancer survivors need help

Almost five years ago I was diagnosed with a rare form of bone cancer called Ewing's Sarcoma. In the middle of my senior year at Brandeis University, I was forced to withdraw from school to receive seven rounds of high-dose chemotherapy at Memorial Sloan-Kettering in New York City. I was declared in remission and I returned to Brandeis in January of 2001 to complete my senior year.

Three months later I was diagnosed with a secondary, pre-leukemic condition called Myelodyspastic Syndrome, and I underwent an allogeneic bone marrow transplant in August of 2001.

As the four-year anniversary of my last day of Ewing's treatment and the three-year anniversary of my transplant approach, I can honestly say I've never felt better.

When I finished treatment and was finally allowed to reclaim my independence, everyone kept saying that I could get "back to normal" and get on with my life. But as a 24-year-old woman who had already graduated from college, I was stuck in an in-between stage.

I had finished college but had not yet gotten a job. I had residual medical bills, the promise of new bills, and was almost too old to be covered by mother's health insurance. I was lucky – I found a job right away and I have excellent health coverage.

Meeting other adult survivors has opened my eyes to the fact that many are not as lucky. Our issues are age-specific and often ignored. No organization existed solely to financially assist young adult survivors with their transition to posttreatment life.

For this reason Bridget Ahearn (a fellow Brandeis alumna) and I have co-founded Surviving and Moving Forward: The SAMFund for Young Adult Survivors of Cancer. We have spent the past year creating an organization that will provide financial assistance to cancer survivors between the ages of 17 and 35.

In the past year our growth and success have far surpassed our expectations. We have formed relationships with many well-known cancer-related organizations.

Our website, www.thesamfund.org, has reached thousands of young adult survivors, caregivers, friends and families.

We have numerous tasks and projects slated for the coming year. All are crucial to our ability to distribute grants and scholarships, which is at the heart of The SAMFund's mission.

Currently Bridget is attending the University of California for graduate work in advanced practice oncology nursing. I am preparing to return to Brandeis for an MBA in Mission-Driven Management. For Bridget and me, what started out as an interest is becoming our career. What we need now is support. Throughout the course of my treatment, my family and I were overwhelmed by the support that poured out from the bridge community. Your donations, cards, thoughts and prayers made many dark days brighter and were so truly appreciated. We are writing now to ask for the same support for other young adults who are struggling with the financial challenges I was fortunate enough to avoid. These young adults have fought the hardest battle of their lives as they enter this new chapter of well-deserved independence.

East won the opening diamond lead with the ace and played the *****K. He switched back to diamonds, and declarer played the jack from dummy – which held! West, Shaya Levit of Israel, ducked!

At the other table the contract and early plays were the same, but West took the $\diamond Q$ and played one back. As a result, declarer was forced to cross his fingers and try the spade finesse. It worked and the suit broke, so he went down only one trick, winning six spades, a heart and a diamond.

Levit's incredible duck made the difference. Now I as declarer had the losing option of playing for the heart finesse. If the hearts were 3-2 with the king onside, I could take two spades, four hearts, two diamonds and a club for nine tricks. I wouldn't need to take the spade finesse.

When David Parizer jumped to 4* he reasoned he was showing both majors with better hearts, (4*would show better spades) but alas, Debbie Drury (what a great name for a bridge player) was on a different wavelength.

As you can see, clubs is not the best spot for East-West on this deal (they took no tricks), but with 5, or possibly 6, on for North-South, I speculated that it might not be such a bad board for East-West.

When David and I checked the scores at the end of the session it turned out North-South had gained 8 IMPs, which suggests several pairs had gone minus on our cards.

Chatting about the deals, David mentioned this one where he found an excellent lead:

With all the side suits under control David found the excellent lead of a trump, and declarer was down before he started. To understand how good a lead that was consider this: when East led a spade at least one declarer won, ruffed a spade, ruffed a diamond, ruffed a spade and played a heart. West won, forced declarer with a spade, won the next heart and forced declarer again. Declarer drew the last trump, and with East having discarded two clubs, played a club to the 9 for plus 650.

NY 2004 is truly an international event

Shoulda stood in bed!


Sometimes it doesn't pay to get up in the morning. On their way to a heavy loss in their Spingold match, Wafik Abdou (playing with Kenji Miyakuni of Japan) found himself in a normal but delicate 4 contract.

His chances improved on a low club lead (third or fifth best) when he scored the AQ. Playing carefully he led a club back to the ace and a spade to the 8. He planned to duck one spade, win the next, cash the A, ruff a club, and try to safety play diamonds one way or another for three tricks and the contract.

However, the first round of trumps brought good news and bad. The &8 held as LHO pitched a club! Since LHO now seemed to be 0-4-4-5, Wafik cashed the &A as East produced the 10. Then he ruffed a club and led a low diamond from dummy. East does best to ruff and lead a heart, but he pitched a heart. So Wafik won his &K, cashed the \checkmark A and led a spade to the jack and queen.

As he had foreseen, this was the ending:



Declarer had collected seven of the first eight tricks, and East could do no better than lead a heart. Wafik ruffed and exited with a diamond. West could win his queen and give partner a ruff, but East was trump endplayed at trick 12 for the contract.

Contract made for plus 420 - 1000 3 IMPs! His teammates got more active and doubled 3 - 1000 but at least they held the opponents to nine tricks for minus 530.

Israel Junior leads World Individual

Lotan Fisher of Israel shot into the lead during the third session of the World Junior Individual Championship yesterday. With 24 deals to go today, he is one percentage point ahead of Michal Nowosadzki of Poland. Gabby Feiler of Australia is third, followed by Michal Kopecky of Czech Republic.



is clear that 12 tricks will depend on the disposition of the enemy trumps.

West led the \$8, and declarer won with the ace and cashed a top spade. Now he set out on a voyage of discovery. He played a club to dummy and ruffed a club, then played three rounds of hearts, ruffing in hand. Then came the \blacklozenge A, a diamond to the king and a trump.

East followed with the 7, and declarer paused to take stock.

East had produced the $\mathbf{A}Q$ on the third round of the suit, suggesting clubs were 5-3. The $\mathbf{A}Q$, if a true card, meant that suit was 4-2. Meanwhile, West had followed to three rounds of hearts. If declarer's calculations were correct, West's shape was 1-3-4-5, so with a fair degree of confidence he finessed the $\mathbf{A}J$.

When West discarded declarer could draw the last trump and give up a diamond for plus 1430.

King's effort with bridge began in the spring of 2001 with what was then called the Bridge Pro Tour. The name changed after last summer's NABC in Long Beach to Prize Money Bridge. In that first year, there were four events. In 2002, there were six prize-money games. The following year, the total had grown to 10, and this year there will be 23. King says there will be 30 games in 2005.

It was a mistake, King says, to dub his effort the Bridge Pro Tour, implying that only pros could participate. Now that it has a more egalitarian focus, more and more players are getting involved.

The games that start today will be in three divisions: Open, Stratified and 299er. If the open game reaches 50 tables, the top prize will be \$4000.

"We want to condition the ACBL membership that money is not the root of all evil," King says.

His ultimate goal, King says, is to have a professional tour with top prize money of \$20,000 to \$30,000 per weekly contest. In his vision, the most successful of the pros could earn up to \$1 million a year playing in the pro tour.

King recalls the transformation he oversaw in the tennis game when he got Phillip Morris to establish the Virginia Slims pro tennis tour. Phillip Morris, King says, spent \$10 million a year for 20 years promoting the women's tennis tour, and in that time made in the neighborhood of \$5 billion. Virginia Slims went from 89th in total sales to 15th by the time the association with women's tennis had ended.

The major offshoot of having a big-time sponsor, King says, is that the sponsor spends lots of money promoting the beneficiary of the sponsorship along with the product.

He recalls that when Virginia Slims signed on to sponsor the tennis tour, there were billboards, magazine ads, television spots – you name it – promoting tennis along with Virginia Slims. King sees the same thing happening for bridge.

All of that, he insists, could change the image of bridge and give it the kind of credibility those who love the game have cherished for a long time.

King agrees that his ultimate goal is a ways off, but he isn't discouraged by the apparent slow progress – or the negative comments about what he has going at present. "Those people are looking at what we have, not what we're trying to do," he says.

He believes that when the top bridge players are earning big bucks "on top of the table" — as opposed to payments from individuals — the public will take notice. "The top players make good money now," King says, "but not in a way that the public can understand."

King believes he will ultimately succeed because bridge is such a good game, and "we have a good story to tell."

He didn't expect everything to happen overnight, and he won't shy away from the task.



No doubt a heart lead and continuation is best, but I led an unimaginative club and was surprised at dummy.

It seems that the best plan for declarer is to ruff a club low and play the $\bigstar J$. Instead, after winning the opening club lead with the ace, declarer cashed dummy's diamonds, then ruffed a club to cash the $\bigstar A$ and pitch dummy's singleton heart.

Aker ruffed and returned a low heart, ruffed in dummy. Now came a club ruff high, a heart ruff, club ruff high and the $\diamond J$, ruffed by Aker with the $\diamond 9$. This was the end position:

Japanese players at the Fall Championships in Orlando."

Most of the Japanese visitors here are women. We wondered why.

"Men don't have enough free time to play in Japan," said Sekizawa. "Theoretically they work only five days a week, but just about everybody has to put in a lot of overtime. When they occasionally have a little free time, they prefer to spend it with their families. Most of the members in the JCBL are middle-aged women."

Just as in the ACBL, the JCBL is making a strong effort to add young people to the bridge fold. They have instituted a special promotional program, and the visitors here are watching closely to see how the ACBL and the World Bridge Federation are handling Juniors.

Sekizawa and her partner, Ayako Amano, were playing in the quarterfinals of the Wagar Women's Knockout Teams as this article was being written. They will represent Japan at the World Team Olympiad in Istanbul, Turkey, this fall. This will be their second appearance in an Olympiad – they also competed for Japan in 2000 in Maastricht, the Netherlands. They advanced through the roundrobin to the quarterfinals but were defeated by Germany. Their teammates in Turkey will be Shoko Fukuda, Kyoko Shimamura, Nobuko Setoguchi and Hiroko Ohta. Their non-playing captain, Tadashi Yoshida, is a competitor at this tournament.

Actually Ayako will be competing in her fourth world championship. On two occasions she played for Venezuela in the Venice Cup.

Sekizawa's interest in bridge skyrocketed when she was assigned as an assistant to the Daily Bulletin editor at the Bermuda Bowl championships in Yokohama, Japan, in 1991. After pulling the last trump, she led a diamond and West won the ace and led a club to partner's queen. On the heart return, Weinstein rose with the ace, dropping the singleton king to wind up with 11 tricks.

At the other table Garber, East, and Cohn, West, defended 2 A and beat it two tricks!

The \bigstar 10 opening lead held the first trick and declarer won the second club. A trump to the 9 and queen was followed by a diamond to the ace. On the diamond return, dummy's king was ruffed, and Garber led a heart, declarer finessing to lose to the singleton king. Garber alertly ruffed the \diamond Q return to give Cohn a heart ruff. Altogether the defense took one club, one spade, one heart, one diamond, two diamond ruffs and one heart ruff. Down two.

South could have done much better to start with a club, getting a force going on the East hand, but he made the reasonable choice of the \bigstar 10 for his opening thrust. Bresler took advantage by cashing three rounds of the suit to pitch his losing club. He started work on trumps at that point, but the defenders had lost the tempo and Bresler finished with 11 tricks for plus 200 and 10 of 11 matchpoints.





Convention card reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both partnership cards must be identical. Both must include the first and last names of each member of the partnership. If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the Standard American Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6 board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director. If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems appropriate under the circumstances.

After starting with three maximums, – 25-2, 25-0 and 25-0 – Q-Plus faced the three-time defending champion Jack, which had already been upset by Microbridge and WBridge5.

After a spirited auction, South led a low spade, and in the twinkling of an eye declarer had finessed, drawn trumps, eliminated diamonds, cashed the A for a club pitch, then cashed the A, followed by a club. The defenders could not prevent plus 1430. If North goes up with the A on the second round of the suit, he blots out his partner's second club honor and makes declarer's A10 good. If North ducks, South wins the club but has to give declarer a ruff-sluff and the club loser goes away.

It was a big swing because Jack stopped in game at the other table.

Jack recovered to tie the match, keeping both programs on course for the semifinals.

Petty did not Alert Smolsky's 4♦ bid, so when she "raised" to $5 \blacklozenge$ he had to treat the bid as though she had a very long diamond suit. Her failure to Alert gave Smolsky information he was not entitled to - that she had forgotten that they play Namyats and he acted accordingly.

Looking at the East hand, if you think partner has a long, strong diamond suit, there are a lot of tricks to be taken with diamonds as trumps. In fact, if Petty's club suit had been diamonds instead, a diamond slam would have been cold.

At any rate, as Cohen pointed out, many players would have thumbed the 5 hid into the table to wake partner up, but not Smolsky. He did the right thing by bidding $6 \blacklozenge$, finishing two down after Berkowitz led his singleton club and took a ruff at trick two.
