# Gitelman is 2005 Honorary Member



"If you're not careful, bridge could ruin your life." That's the warning that Ted Horning gave Fred Gitelman many years ago. Gitelman ignored that advice, and now he is the 2005 Honorary ACBL Member of the Year.

Gitelman is special. His bridge programs have made a major difference for hundreds of thousands of bridge players. He has been active in promoting Junior bridge. He is a talented writer. He has served on many important bridge committees. He has coached some of America's international teams. And he's a fine bridge player as well – he placed second in the 1995 Bermuda Bowl, for example.

But this article isn't about Gitelman's's accomplishments. It's about Fred – the real Fred.

Most bridge players have heard that Gitelman plays bridge with Bill Gates of Microsoft fame. How did that ever come about?

Surprisingly it started with Warren Buffett, the internationally famous financial guru.

One day Gitelman got a phone call from someone who said, "I really like your software.

## Playing here makes his birthday happy

When Wendy Wheeler and John Chapman arrived in Orlando for the Fall NABC, the bridge lessons they had just completed were still fresh in their minds. They had about half a masterpoint each.

In the three days they spent in Orlando, the married couple, who live in Little Rock AR, played in eight sessions in the newcomer games, more than quadrupling their masterpoints totals.

They left their first bridge tournament with a conviction that taking up the game was a very good decision. "We have had a blast," says Wheeler.

The two, married a year in August, met on the job. They both work for Alltel Communications, a wireless company.

They got their introduction to bridge when they went to a family get-together in Las Vegas, where a bridge tournament was going on. Wheeler's sister,

# Italy's Lauria now No. 1 in the world

Lorenzo Lauria of Italy has taken over the No. 1 position in the World Bridge Federation as a result of his remarkable series of performances in major European and world competition. He also has been very successful at North American championships.

He displaced Bob Hamman, who was the top player in the world in WBF rankings for 20 years.

Lauria was a member of the victorious Italian team at the World Team Olympiad in Istanbul earlier this month. That victory was the one that moved him ahead of Hamman.

He has won two World Team Olympiads (2000 and 2004) and two Rosenblum Teams (1998 and 2002. Add to that four triumphs in the European Team Championships (1979, 1995, 1997 and 2002) three consecutive wins in the European Bridge League Challenge Cup (2002 to 2004) and a win in the International Olympic Committee Grand Prix in 1999. Strangely enough, he has never won a Bermuda Bowl, although he has three seconds (1979, 1983 and 2003).

His international career first blossomed in 1979 in the Bermuda Bowl in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. His partner was the incomparable Giorgio Belladonna. The Americans were well ahead going into the final 16-board segment, but Lauria and Belladonna had a superb final set. They were sure they had overcome the Americans' lead, but they missed by 5 IMPs. Belladonna was so disappointed that he cried as he rode the elevator away from the playing area.

Lauria once again is here for the North American Championships. He has become a regular at NABCs.

#### Greco, Hampson lead Blue Ribbon

Eric Greco and Geoff Hampson, runners-up in the Blue Ribbon Pairs last year, took a narrow lead into the second day of play in the event, which concludes on Thanksgiving Day.

Greco and Hampson, already established as one of ACBL's top pairs, held a lead of slightly more



#### **Bridge Today Daily** To Cover or Not

#### By Matthew Granovetter

Rules don't work always at bridge. Situations change and then there are mistakes to worry about. Not every declarer plays perfectly. The right play against the wrong person could be the wrong play. Try this one. The ♠Q is led from dummy, do you cover or not?

> Dummy **▲** QJ9764 You **♦**K 10

Suppose South has opened 1NT and North transferred to this suit. When the queen is led from dummy, declarer may hold the ace-doubleton. In this case, you had better cover, and you'll have a good chance to score the 10 on the next round. Even if South holds A-x-x, it pays to cover, giving declarer a guess on the next round. If declarer holds A-x-x, it probably won't matter whether you cover or not - he's going to finesse. Probably. Here was an interesting position from the afternoon pair games yesterday.

I was West and led the ◆K. Declarer won in dummy and called for the AQ. My partner played the 10. This turned out to be a crucial play. Declarer was suddenly faced with a matchpoint decision: to play for 10 tricks, 11 tricks or 12 tricks.

If he finessed, he would make 10 or 12 tricks – if the finesse won, he would draw trumps and discard a diamond on the third round of hearts, but if the finesse lost, he would lose two diamond tricks and score only 10 tricks. Declarer finally decided to go up with the A, settling for exactly 11 tricks. He then took his diamond discard.

Well, as you may have spotted by now, declarer should cash three top hearts before playing on trumps. Then he can go to dummy in clubs and finesse spades without risk. But that's not the point. People do make little mistakes. When declarer called for the AQ at trick two, he made a little mistake, and I was glad I was not sitting in my partner's seat. I would have cleverly covered with the king to score the 10 on the next round. That would not have been a sparkling play. Later I asked my partner why he didn't cover, and he responded that since he doesn't know most of his opponents, he sometimes covers and sometimes doesn't randomly. Well, that strategy worked!

Theirs was the singing table, everything from "Doo Wah Diddy" (Manfred Mann) to show tunes such as "Oklahoma!" They even had a Japanese friend joining in the chorus on the latter tune.

For part of the game, Meyers and Seamon-Molson were singing the blues about their bad luck and some unfortunate choices, but they rallied at the end to post a reasonable score and stay in the hunt for a spot in the semifinal round.

Seamon-Molson's bid on the following deal had Meyers singing "Happy Days Are Here Again."

Seamon-Molson's decision to ignore her fivecard spade suit worked out very well for her side, although if East had put his hand on a club for the opening lead it would have been a different story.

One can hardly blame East for starting proceedings for his side with a low spade – with no Stayman or transfer by South and with no semblance of an entry to his hand, a club lead seemed unlikely to be effective.

Meyers won the spade in hand and played a heart to dummy's ace at trick two, continuing the suit to her jack as West ducked. A third round of hearts put West in, and he exited with his last heart. The handwriting was on the wall, however. Meyers played a diamond to dummy's king and West's ace, and he played a diamond to her queen.

On the run of the spades, West was squeezed in the minors, and Meyers' last two tricks were the ♣A and the ♠8. Plus 660 was good for 35.5 out of 38 matchpoints.

Meyers and Seamon-Molson had a great last round to add a couple of percentage points to their game.On the next-to-last deal, the theme song for East-West could have been "Smoke Gets in Your Eyes."

East led the ◆9, and Meyers put in dummy's jack. West won the ◆K and put the ◆K on the table. Despite East's encouraging ◆9, West switched to a low club. Meyers romped home with the rest of the tricks for plus 660 and 31.5 matchpoints.

# Don't give up!

On this deal from the Flight A/X Swiss Teams, Craig Robinson and Elaine Landow reached 6., making it easily after a trump lead.

Against the spade slam at our table (I was West), I led the ◆J. Planning to pitch his diamond losers on dummy's hearts, declarer won the ◆A. When the second round of trumps revealed the 5-1 break, South regretted not having let the diamond ride to his queen.

Declarer played dummy's three high hearts, discarding his diamonds, then started clubs. My partner, Bruce Keidan, won the ♣A and fatally forced declarer with the ♥10. South ruffed and played more high trumps and two winning clubs, but trick 13 went to East's long trump. The IMP pickup helped our team to win the event.

Rather than allow his lament over his trick-one choice to deter him, South should have asked himself, "How can I make the contract?" Have you spotted the solution?

By playing hearts before drawing trumps, declarer opens the suit for East's forcing play. Instead, South should draw all of East's trumps and hope the defender with the A started with a singleton diamond. If not, the contract is down additional tricks but probably very few IMPs.

On the final board, East was "On My Own" in his final action, leaving him reaching for an "Impossible Dream" with very little to show for it.

East started with the ◆A, switching to his singleton club at trick two. That ran to the queen and ace, and Meyers played a spade to the king and another to the ace, picking up that suit. She had a long club in dummy to take care of her losing heart, and she emerged with 12 tricks for plus 790 and 34.5 matchpoints.

Informed of the musical afternoon at table 9 in the Blue Ribbon Pairs, Sid Brownstein, Meyers' husband, had this comment: "Jill loves to sing."

#### Sometimes you're lucky

#### By Barry Rigal

Some suit combinations require a counter-intuitive approach. Consider:

If you were declarer as South and wanted not to lose a trick, you'd cash the king and lead to the jack, right?

Now say you are declarer in a suit contract. You are lucky enough to receive the lead of the 10 to your jack. So you win the jack and after drawing trumps you cash the king and lead the 9. East alertly covers, so his 8 is good enough to stop the suit on the fourth round.

Fair enough. Can you do better?

The answer is yes, but it is counter-intuitive. Of course you must assume the suit splits 4-2, long on your right. Win the king at trick one! Then after drawing trumps run the 9, covered by the queen and ace. Go back to dummy and pass the 7, and whether it is covered or not you have a fourth-round winner.

Having taken all that into consideration, consider Board 10 from the second Board-a-Match final.

You do well to stop in  $2 \spadesuit$  as West. Even at board-a-match 2NT figures to take no more than seven tricks if the heart finesse loses. On the  $\blacktriangledown 10$  lead, remembering the advice above you win the king, draw trumps, pass the  $\blacktriangledown 9$ , and the  $\blacktriangledown 8$  puts in a premature appearance. So any line in the suit leads to 10 tricks. Note that in notrump you must tackle hearts early.

As East declaring notrump on a spade lead, you must take care to play hearts before diamonds. Win the spade in hand, play the ♥K and a heart to the jack. The fall of the 10-8 lets you cross to the ◆A, pass the ♥9 and make plus 150. Now that's lucky!

What do you recommend?" Gitelman went into his usual sales pitch, and the man told Gitelman what he wanted. When he gave his address, he started, "My name is Warren Buffett."

Gitelman decided to try to follow up on this and asked if Buffett would give him some business advice. He received a reply that said, "I think your software is fantastic, Please feel free to use my endorsement as you see fit."

Buffett offered one major piece of advice: "You must find partners to work with. The most important thing to look for is integrity. There has to be trust."

Buffett told his friends about Gitelman, and one of those friends was Bill Gates.

Three years later Buffett and Gates decided to take a train ride from Alaska to California, and the plan was to play a lot of bridge. Sharon Osberg was their third, but they needed a fourth So Gitelman got another historic phone call – this time from someone who said he was with the Bill Gates Estate. It was an invitation to join the trio on the train as a fourth. Buffett had suggested, "Why don't we get Fred," and Osberg said it was a good idea – Gitelman would fit right in.

So Gitelman flew to Bozeman MT – first class for the first time – and got on the train.

"We played bridge for 12 hours a day for the remainder of the trip," Gitelman said.

The relationship blossomed. "We get together every once in a while and just play and play. I'm going to be playing with Bill at a Seattle Sectional in a couple of weeks. Bill likes duplicate very much – he loves competition. Warren prefers the social games."

Now that he is so successful, Gitelman has a major bridge goal. "I want to have a positive impact on the game. I'm concerned about numbers. I'm afraid that we won't have many players by the time I'm your age. I hope I can make a difference through the work I do."

Gitelman's interest in bridge goes back to when he was six years old. "I used to watch my mother and father play with friends. Then they gave up the game for a while and I got caught up in computers. I guess you might say I'm compulsive — I sat in front of a computer most of the time until I was 17.

"In high school there were three fellows who liked to play bridge, and they needed a fourth. They knew I was into computers, so they thought I was the kind of person who'd be okay in bridge. I was instantly hooked. I gave up computers and did nothing but play bridge. I started playing in club games, sometimes skipping school to do so."

One of his teachers was Ray Jotcham, a fine bridge player in his own right. "He helped foster my interest. I'd study and read books, and then I'd talk to him so I could put everything in focus.

"Ted Horning also was a very positive influence. He was a pro, but he started playing with me and didn't charge. He liked me and thought I had promise.

"I think that living in Toronto helped my bridge career. There are lots of great players there, and they are willing to help young players come along. That's why so many Toronto youngsters have done so well – players like Geoff Hampson and the Wolpert brothers, Darren and Gavin. We always have 15 or 20 young players who do well."

Gitelman came along that way as well. The Canadian Junior team of which he was a member earned a silver medal in the 1991 World Junior Championships.

"I dropped out of college after four years and concentrated completely on bridge. Then I met Sheri about three years later, and she convinced me that I should start my own business writing bridge software. The first five years were very stressful — we were on the verge of giving it up every time that bills were due. Then all of a sudden things started

to get better."

Gitelman believes there were two reasons for the turnabout. First, he was beginning to have success as a player, so his name began to have credibility. Second, millions of people were buying computers – computers were beginning to become a regular household item.

Now Bridge Base Online is making bridge players around the world happy – and it's free! As many as 300,000 players per day log in, and at any given moment there are as many as 5000 people playing.

Gitelman took a moment to pay tribute to Uday Ivatury, the third member of the software company that includes Fred and his wife Sheri. "I needed help, and Uday volunteered. He worked night and day for six months and never asked for a cent. Finally I made him an offer and he accepted. He's the best computer programmer I've ever met."

Gitelman believes the online program is good for the game. "It's high quality. I've had help from volunteers all over the world, and they constantly come up with ideas for improvement. Strangely enough, though — most of the company's sales come from educational CDs. But I guess that makes sense since the online game is free."

### Honor your partner

#### By Mark Horton

Consider your partner to be a friend. Treat your partner well, even (especially) if you are playing together for the first time. Always offer your partner a drink — tea or coffee is a good starting point. This will lead to a relaxed atmosphere, enabling you both to play your best. By the way, always be a pleasant and courteous opponent.

Tolerate errors. Never go on about partner's mistakes — just forget about them and move on to the next deal. You may be able to make a constructive comment at the end of the session. Your partner will surely show you the same consideration.

Be encouraging. Always be prepared to support your partner — "well played" always goes down well and a "thank you" for the dummy does not go amiss. In one of my partnerships, if dummy was exactly what was needed, "mille grazie" would let partner in on the good news!

Keep a straight face. Never make the mistake of pulling a face or raising an eyebrow. Apart from hurting your partner's feelings, being deadpan does not let your opponents know that something may have gone wrong.

Win or lose, always stay calm at the end of the session and thank partner for the game. This is especially important if things have not gone so well. In my most successful international partnership, the first time we played together was absolutely hopeless but we stuck with it.

Coping with disaster: The best way to cope with the inevitable disasters is to laugh them off. This tends to disconcert even the best opponents who are used to seeing their opponents argue.

Conventions: Stick to the ones you both feel comfortable with. A player trying to remember some convention he is not familiar with will make errors in other departments.

Netherlands with a strange partner. We would have won but for a couple of expensive mistakes when I forgot a couple of things because we were playing some conventions I was not familiar with.

Who's the boss? In most partnerships, one player tends to be regarded as the boss. If you are the stronger player, go out of your way to make life easy for your partner: make easy-to-understand bids, leads and signals. Don't land your partner in a tough contract — well, not on purpose.

Have fun! You are both out to enjoy yourselves. If your partner leaves the table feeling happy, you have done your job. Of course you want to win but that objective should not mean spoiling the game for your partner or the opponents.

contract made time and time again.

You probably can imagine what happens: South, oblivious to the way partner has played his spades (low-high, indicating at least three), plays a third top spade. West ruffs and that's the end of the story. West's losing clubs are discarded on the top diamonds.

Just so this never happens to you, here's a hint: pay close attention to the size of the spot card partner leads. If his second card is higher than the first, partner must have at least one more card in the suit.

If his second card is lower than the first card, however, partner is leading from a doubleton. Notice how this comes into play here. Partner leads the \$4\$ and the next spade he plays — the \$5\$ — is higher than the first.

Translation: partner has another spade and declarer is out. That in itself is not a reason to play a third spade. Indeed, on other layouts it might well be the killing defense.

Not, however, on this layout. Given the vulnerability plus the ♥K in dummy, declarer surely has a solid trump suit — and those diamonds in dummy look positively scary.

What you must do is shift to a low club at trick three. Whichever club declarer plays, your side will take two club tricks. Down one and on to the next deal.

Point to remember: When leading partner's unsupported suit, lead low from three or four low cards so you can play a higher card the second time to show length. With a doubleton, play high-low.

If you have supported, lead the 8 from 8–6–3 or 8–6–3–2 to deny an honor. Partner knows you don't have a doubleton, so this time your job is to tell partner you don't have a honor. If you have an honor, lead low.

With the A-x-x in partner's suit, supported or not, lead the ace against a suit contract but lead a low card against notrump.

When it was over, Samuel Ieong could only shake his head at the lost opportunity. Still, even thinking about what might have been was fun



his chance to make his contract by pitching a spade from hand. Observe what happens if he does so. South is caught in an unusual, non-material squeeze. He cannot discard a spade or all of declarer's spades will be good. It doesn't help, however, for South to let go of a diamond. If he does so as dummy ruffs the 13th club, Ieong could then play the AQ and the AIO to his ace, unblocking the suit, then exit with his AIO.

What can South do then? If he hops with the ◆A, Ieong has only two diamond losers, and he makes his contract for the loss of three hearts and two diamonds. If he plays low, Ieong plays any diamond from dummy and sits back and waits for North to continue a diamond to South's bare ace, leaving South on lead with ♠J 8 as Ieong waited with the ♠K 9.

Alas, as Ieong confessed, "I got greedy." Instead of pitching a spade, Ieong discarded the ◆2, the correct play if spades were breaking – he would then take nine tricks. Once he pitched the diamond, however, Ieong could not make his contract.

His score for down one was not terrible – many pairs were higher – but Ieong was annoyed with himself for missing the opportunity.
