Pittsburgh-area team leads Women's Swiss

It's a close race in the NABC Women's Swiss Teams, with a hometown squad leading all qualifiers.

Jane Marshall and Gene Keidan of Pittsburgh, Constance Hoechstetter of Coraopolis and Anne Zwack of Allison Park go into today's finals in first place. They scored a total of 105 Victory Points in the two-session qualifying on Saturday.

In second place, just one Victory Point behind the leaders, are Carol Sanders of Nashville TN, Libby Fernandez of Tuscaloosa AL, and Sue Weinstein and Darlene Hammond of Las Vegas NV

The third-place qualifiers, with 102 Victory Points, are Suzy Burger of West Bloomfield MI, Marilyn Maddox of Pleasant Ridge MI, Susan Parnes of Flint MI and Carol Kasle of Bloomfield MI

Two teams tied for lead in Jacoby Open Swiss

Teams captained by Perry Johnson, Bloomfield Hills MI, and Winthrop Allegaert, New York City, each scored 121 Victory Points to tie for the lead in the Jacoby Open Swiss.

Playing with Johnson are Jeff Meckstroth of Tampa FL, Paul Soloway of Mill Creek WA and Eric Rodwell of Clearwater Beach FL.

Allegaert's team includes Judith Bianco, Aaron Silverstein and Chris Willenken, all of New York City.

The third-place qualifiers, with 112 Victory Points, are George Jacobs and Ralph Katz of Hinsdale IL, Steve Garner and Howard Weinstein of Sarasota FL, and Lorenzo Lauria and Alfredo Versace of Rome, Italy.

Schwartz too strong for Onstott in Vandy win

The team captained by Richard Schwartz jumped out to a 50-IMP lead after one quarter to run away with the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams, defeating the John Onstott squad 169-125 in a match that was never close.

The champions are Schwartz, Mike Becker, David Berkowitz, Larry Cohen and Italians Andrea Buratti and Massimo Lanzarotti.

For Onstott, the loss ended an impressive run for the original No. 23 seed. Along the way, they knocked off the No. 10 seed (Reese Milner) and No. 2 (Nick Nickell). Playing with Onstott were Jim Robison, Drew Casen, Jim Krekorian, Samuel Cohen and Chris Compton.

Schwartz has now won the Vanderbilt three times, Becker five times, including once (in 1981) with his father, B. Jay Becker, who won the event eight times. The victory was the first for

New Yorkers set pace in NAP-B Donald Dalpe of Baldwinsville NY and

Donald Dalpe of Baldwinsville NY and Richard Olanoff of de Witt NY scored 1133.71 in two qualifying sessions of the Golder North American Pairs Flight B to take the lead heading into today's final. With a top of 37, that's nearly two board ahead of second place.

In the runner-up spot with two sessions left to play were Joon Pahk and Samuel Leong of Stanford CA. They were just ahead of two Canadian players, Hindupuram Sriharsha of Orillia ON and Leigh Ives of Barrie ON.

Jerry Cohen and Marielle Brentnall of Winnipeg MB were in fourth.

California pair lead NAP-C

Jiang Chen of San Jose CA and Nongyu Li of Mountain View CA took a commanding lead after two qualifying sessions of the President's Cup North American Pairs Flight C. The event concludes today. On a 37 top, the leaders were nearly 3.5 boards ahead of second.

With two sessions to play, the Californians' were 127.5 matchpoints up on Richard Collette and Sebastien Lachance of the Montreal area. In third, not far behind them were two Ohio players, Edward Westmeyer of Holland and Kip Westmeyer of Perrysburg.

Only one matchpoint back, in fourth place, were Lesley Thomson and Stephen Foster of Toronto ON.

Tournament chair: NABC success was a team effort



Five years ago, the job of chair of the 2005 Spring NABC fell to Roni Gitchel. Her first move was a phone call to Memphis.

"I asked Nancy Foy and Jeff Johnston (in ACBL's Meeting Services Department), 'What do I do?' and they told me."

Of course, Gitchel also had to put together various committees and recruit volunteers to get things ready for several thousand bridge players over the course of 11 days, but she has no regrets about the long hours and hard work on the tournament.

"I've seen people having a good time," Gitchel says, "and I think most of the players have enjoyed themselves."

Gitchel says none of it would have happened without her committees and volunteers. "They

Indian Junior testing himself in U.S. tournaments



Prahalad Raikumar has set big goals for himself. He wants to earn a university degree, become a software developer, play lots of bridge and win a national championship in an ACBL tournament.

At age 21, he's already made so much progress that he's a favorite to accomplish all that and more

A native of Chennai, India, Prahalad learned bridge at age 14 from his dad, who is an Indian national champion. Prahalad played in many highlevel tournaments during his high-school years. He placed third in a major IMP Pair event in his home country and was named to the Indian Junior Team in 2001.

"A few times, I skipped my mid-year exams to go to the Indian Nationals," Prahalad said. "There were no make-up exams, but I was doing so well in my courses that my instructors just let it go by."

Prahalad came to the U.S. three years ago to study computer science at the University of Maryland. He played in Washington DC and New York City NABCs, where he entered as many championship events as possible. He particularly likes the major team events.

"I really enjoy being able to practice and improve and learn from other players," Prahalad said. "I want to play against the best, and I hope to one day make a strong showing in the Spingold or Vanderbilt."

Prahalad says the tournament events are very different in his home country. There are no flighted or stratified events, and the national organization doesn't have the resources to promote youth bridge. Teens and other newcomers must play in the open sections at Indian tournaments.

Prahalad hasn't played in any Junior events for the past three years, but he has strong praise for ACBL's program and its participants.

"There are so many more opportunities here in the U.S. for young players," Prahalad said. "I have a strong appreciation for all of ACBL's efforts to teach in the schools and encourage junior bridge."

Here in Pittsburgh, Prahalad entered the Vanderbilt and lost to the powerful Meltzer team. Since then, his team has won a compact KO event and placed second in the top bracket of the foursession Toyes-Giftes Knockout Teams. His teammates were G. Venkatesh, Los Altos CA; G. Prabhu, Ames IA; and R. Rajkumar (his father), Kanningat Krishnakumar and P. Ridhar, all of Chennai, India. On Friday, Prahalad and Venkatesh finished 13th in the Lebhar IMP Pairs.

Perhaps his most impressive showing in a championship event was in New York City, where Prahalad and his 15-year-old brother placed 32nd in the finals of the Life Master Pairs last summer.

In New York, Paul Soloway visited the Daily Bulletin office to report on a diabolical ruse an opponent had pulled on him in the Life Master Pairs. Soloway didn't know the young man's name at the time, but he does now. It was Prahalad, who held:

Prahalad chose to respond 1♠ to his partner's opening 1♥ bid and heard Soloway, on his left, bid a natural 2♠. When this was passed back to him, Prahalad bid a smooth 3NT.

Soloway held

▲ A K 7 4 3 2 ♥ 3 ◆ J 8 4 2 ♣ A 2 and was totally deceived. He was intent on not giving declarer a spade trick, so he led diamonds on opening lead and again when he was in with the ♣A. This was not a successful defense, as the full deal was:

As soon as Soloway made his second diamond lead, Prahalad showed his hand and claimed 12 tricks. All Soloway could do was look on in admiration.

"It was like re-raising in poker with nothing," said Soloway. "He made a terrific bid of 1 ♠ − and his 3NT bid was out of this world. He earned his top."

Kessler surges past 10,000

His teammates were John Russell, N. Barrington IL; Barry Harper, Regina SK; Jack Bryant, St. Louis MO; and Darrell Keel and Steve Bruno, Peoria AZ.

On the way to winning both the Sunday and Monday Open Pair events, Mark Itabashi of Murrieta CA and Eric Leong of Oakland CA had two especially memorable deals. Each involved a position in the heart suit that gave the opponents a chance to make an error.


On the first deal (Board 15 from Sunday evening), Leong and Itabashi pushed their opponents to 5 \(\blacktriangle \), then found a way to talk them out of making it.

Itabashi cashed the ♣A on opening lead and shifted to a low spade. East drew four rounds of trumps and led the ♠K. Itabashi knew that ducking the diamond was the best way to keep declarer out of dummy, but he also realized that would force declarer to lay down the ♥A and drop his singleton ♥K.

Itabashi made sure declarer had his dummy entry by offering up the Greek "gift" of winning the diamond and exiting with the ◆J. Declarer could now run four diamond tricks, but eventually took the losing heart finesse for down one.

The next day, Leong found himself in 6♥ on this deal (Board 29 from Monday evening; hands rotated):



The opening lead was the ◆10, low from dummy, ◆Q from East. Leong won the ◆A and considered how to play the trump suit. The normal safety play of running the ♥J clearly wasn't safe on this deal, as East was known to have a singleton diamond. But it certainly wouldn't cost anything to give East the illusion that a finesse was coming.

Leong crossed to dummy with the ♣A and led the ♥J to see if he could induce a cover. It worked – East split his honors and Leong was home free with 12 easy tricks. Had East smoothly ducked the ♥J, Leong would have undoubtedly gone up with the ♥A and gone down in the slam, but he gave himself the free extra chance and was rewarded with plus-1430.

not count 2 high-card points for that ♥Q after North's vulnerable two-level overcall. It's unlikely to be worth the cardboard it's printed on.

Defensive commentary: South starts a highlow with the ♥10 and North continues with the king and jack.

Play commentary: With a heart overruff impending, West does best to discard a diamond from dummy, a sure loser in any event. The intention is to ruff a third diamond in dummy after drawing two rounds of trumps. It's a primo idea, but. . .

Defensive commentary: When South sees what West is up to, he can frustrate West by also discarding a diamond at trick three. Now West cannot ruff a diamond as South can overruff. Down one.

Stray jacks and queens in suits that have been bid by the opponents are unlikely to be worth much. Count them at your own risk. However, if partner bids notrump after the opponents have bid a suit, jacks and queens in that suit retain their value.

When faced with a certain dummy overruff, consider the possibility of discarding a loser from dummy in a second suit where declarer also has a loser. The idea is to ruff that loser later.

Glossary of bridge terms

New members of ACBL are often confused by the array of terms they hear: knockout teams, red points, rookie. Here's a list of terms and their meanings:

Knockout Teams: an event in which a team (of four, five or six players — with four playing at a time) plays another team. The losers are eliminated or "knocked out" while the winners play other winners until only one team remains undefeated.

The length of a KO match may vary from a single session to a full day (the Vanderbilt and Spingold) to a multi-day event (the Bermuda Bowl).

Bracketed Knockout Teams: a KO event in which teams are divided into groups — usually of 8, 16 or 32 teams — based on their masterpoint holdings. The top group — Bracket I — and all other groups compete in a separate event with their own set of winners.

Compact Knockout Teams: a shorter version of Bracketed KO teams.

Swiss Teams: an event in which a team (of four, five or six players — with four playing at a time) plays other teams in seven-, eight- or nine-board matches. Team A sits North-South at Table 1 and East-West at Table 2 while Team B sits East-West at Table 1 and North-South at Table 2.

The results are compared and scored by International Match Points (IMPs).

Pairings for the first round are random. Pairings for succeeding rounds are determined by a team's win-loss record or Victory Point total.

International Match Points (IMPs): the most common method of scoring Swiss Team matches. If Team A scores plus 620 for bidding and making 4♠ on Board 4 and Team B scores only plus 170 (they didn't bid the game), the difference is 450 — which converts to 10 IMPs. The IMP chart is shown on the inside of your convention card.

Victory Points (VPs): a method of scoring Swiss Team matches. After the scores are compared and converted to IMPs, the IMP total is converted to Victory Points. A team's VP total may be used to determine its next opponents and its final standing.

Side Game Series: single-session pair games that pay red points. The Morning Side Game Series I, for example, will be played at 9:00 a.m. the first Friday, Saturday and Sunday of the Reno NABC. Pairs may play in one, two or three sessions. Only pairs who play in at least two sessions are eligible for overall gold points.

Flighted pairs: When flighting is used, the field is divided by expertise or experience or both into several separate games. Flight A — "unlimited masterpoints" — will be open to all players while the remaining flights will be limited. Flight B might be 0-500 MPs or 0-1000 MPs while Flight C might be 0-300 or 0-500.

Each flight is scored individually, and masterpoint awards are made for each flight.

The masterpoint holdings of the players determine their flight. If one player is quite expert while his partner is new to the game, the pair must compete in Flight A.

In flighted events, you may play up but not down. That means you may play in Flight A or Flight B even if your masterpoint holding qualifies you for Flight C. Conversely, you may not play in Flight B or Flight C if you are a Flight A player.

Stratified Pairs: The idea is to compete against everyone but to be ranked only with your peers.

Each pair is assigned a stratum or "strat" based on the masterpoint holding of the partner with more masterpoints.

Example: A = 1500+ masterpoints; B = 500-

1500 MPs; C = 0-500 MPs.

Thus, the most experienced players are placed in Strat A, intermediate players in Strat B and less experienced players in Strat C. Masterpoints are awarded for placings in all strats but gold points are awarded only in A and B.

The game proceeds normally — the difference comes when the scores are tabulated and ranked.

In a three-strat game, the scores are ranked three times. The first ranking is done as in a regular open game. These are the Strat A results.

If a B or C pair does well in this ranking, they receive full credit for that performance. It is not all that uncommon for a Strat C pair to place first overall, and they receive the full masterpoint award for that game.

Note: A pair is eligible for only one set of masterpoint awards and automatically receives the highest award.

The second ranking compares the scores of only the B and C pairs — the scores of the Strat A pairs are eliminated. Once again, if a C pair does well, they receive points for their finishing position in the Strat B results.

The third and final ranking compares the scores of only the C pairs — all the scores of the Strat A and B pairs are eliminated.

Strati-flighted Pairs: The top group plays in a game of their own — Flight A. The rest of the field in divided into strats and plays as in a regular stratified pairs.

A recent innovation has been stratifying within Flight A. Flight A-1 may be listed as 3000+ MPs while Flight A-2 (or Flight X) may be listed as 0-3000 MPs.

Pittsburgh player's goal: bridge-for-credit courses

All her life, Liberty Pyros of Pittsburgh has been overcoming obstacles. The first one she remembers occurred when she was in the first grade, trying to make her way despite speaking almost no English.

Pyros's parents, both born in Greece, spoke only their native language at home, so when Liberty went to school for the first time she was at a distinct disadvantage. With the help of a friend's comic books, she learned her second language.

As an adult, she accepted the challenge of being the first female computer engineer at Westinghouse, a job that came with a good bit of pressure. When she was hired she was told that if she did well they might offer similar jobs to other women.

Now, Pyros, a bridge player and teacher, is facing a new challenge – getting local colleges to offer bridge courses for credit. She has been teaching bridge at the University of Pittsburgh and at the Community College of Allegheny County and she has worked up a presentation concerning why the courses should be for credit.

Pyros, who has lived most of her life in the Pittsburgh area, learned bridge while she was attending Bethany College in West Virginia. She wandered into the student center one day and was asked if she played bridge. She said no, and the next question was, "Do you play cards?" Pyros said she did. "Then sit down," she was told.

Back in Pittsburgh, she was working for National Cash Register when a co-worker introduced her to duplicate at a game at the downtown YMCA. She played with the man's girlfriend the next time and they won. "I was hooked," she says.

The soft-spoken bridge and math teacher was born Liberty Zabetakis. She married Andy Pyros in 1964, and they had four children. She had started teaching bridge in her neighborhood, using a book by George Gooden. One day, she saw an ad in the newspaper for the local community college requesting proposals for new classes.

Here was another challenge. "I was new at the game myself, and I had to work up the nerve to say I could teach it."

She called the community college and proposed teaching bridge, and they accepted. She has even written her own teaching manual, entitled "A Bridge to Creative Thinking."

Her approach encompasses more than just teaching rules. "I train the mind how to think," she says.

Although she has not had success so far in getting bridge into colleges for credit, Pyros isn't discouraged. "I keep at it," she says. "I love to teach."

Table count near 9000

Not counting the midnight game, the table count at the 2005 Spring NABC in Pittsburgh reached 8977 on Saturday.

High stakes

This deal comes from the afternoon session of the Bill Bazerman Stratified Open Pairs. It's up to you to decide whether the board number (13) had anything to do with the outcome.

Any redoubled contract usually results in a top for one side or the other.

Suppose South leads a club. The defense now threatens to score two club ruffs, two diamond tricks, a heart and a natural spade trick. As the cards lie, declarer is powerless to stop it.

There are a number of variations in the play, but they all lead to six defensive tricks:

- 1. Declarer tries to draw trumps. North wins the second spade and uses diamonds twice to get to South for club ruffs. After the last ruff, he exits with a heart and dummy is dead.
- 2. Declarer tries to set up the third diamond. South wins, gives a ruff and North leads back a heart
- 3. Declarer simply gives up ruffs. North exits with a heart sooner.

So, have North-South found their perfect matchpoint spot of plus 400?

Well, let's say that my choice of opening leads – the $\forall K$ – was not optimal for the defense.

Entries

All North American championships with no upper masterpoint limitation: \$16.50

(Note: only ACBL members are eligible to play in NABC+ events.)

Other North American championships: \$15 (Note: only ACBL members are eligible to play in these events.)

Regional championships: \$14 for ACBL members, \$16 for all others

All other events: \$13 for ACBL members, \$15 for all others.

Monitoring

At this and future North American championships, ACBL will be monitoring NABC+ events with visible, real-time cameras. The images will be recorded and will be available for later official inspection and review.

By general monitoring of the session and participants' behavior, ACBL has another source of information that may be useful in determining facts and settling issues arising from some types of ethical and behavioral complaints or actions. This procedure is intended to assure everyone that the playing field is level and that misbehavior will not be tolerated.

New pre-Alert/ Disclosure forms

If your partnership plays special overcalls, you must fill out a new pre-Alert/Disclosure form and make it available to your opponents when you play in events that allow Mid-Chart and Super-Chart conventions.


This applies to NABC+, regional or higher knockout and Flight A Swiss games. Look for the light blue forms on the table where convention cards are available.

Playing time

Mike Flader is a busy tournament director who also writes the Ruling the Game column for the ACBL Bridge Bulletin. As such, he doesn't get to play a lot. He managed four sessions in the Lebhar IMP Pairs at the Spring NABC, finishing an impressive 11th overall with Warren Foss of Omaha NE as his partner.

This deal from the first final session shows that Flader, of Eagan MN, can make good plays as well as good rulings. The opponents were Chip Martel and Martin Fleisher.



Flader started with the A and continued with a spade to his partner's jack. Martel ruffed the third round of spades low, then entered dummy with the A, followed by a club. When Foss showed out of trumps, Martel put in the queen from his hand. Flader won the king and, instead of carelessly playing back a low trump, he got out with the 49.

Consider how the play would go if he exited with a low club. Martel wins the \$6 in hand, ruffs a diamond in dummy, cashes the top hearts, pitching his other losing diamond, then ruffs a heart to hand high, pulls Flader's trumps and claiming for one down.

After the return of the \$9, it's a different story. Martel wins in hand with a high club, ruffs the diamond with dummy's \$8, and when he attempts to get back to his hand with a heart ruff, Flader's \$7 turns into a trick sooner or later.

Also of interest: on a double-dummy basis, Martel could have made 10 tricks for down one without a diamond ruff simply by winning and running his trump winners, catching East in a redsuit squeeze

In any event, plus 500 was good for 8.67 IMPs for Flader and Foss.

New Life Masters

Ernie Dalton of Miamisburg OH was on the winning team in the Compact Knockout Consolation, earning enough masterpoints to become a Life Master. His partner was his wife, Judith, and their teammates were Marilyn and Wayne O'Connor of Centerville OH.

Joan and Tony Viidik of Waterloo ON earned their gold cards playing in the semifinal round of knockout on Saturday.

When using bid boxes, ACBL suggests that players tap the Alert strip and say "Alert" at the same time.

When making an announcement, use the announcement word — such as "transfer" — and tap the Alert strip at the same time.

A player who Alerts or announces a bid should make sure his opponents are aware that an Alert or announcement has been made.

Berkowitz in a major knockout event. His partner, Cohen, now has won all the major ACBL team events, including the Grand National Teams and the Spingold Knockout Teams.

Convention card reminder

- Each player must have an ACBL convention card filled out and on the table. Please note that other types of convention cards, such as the WBF convention card or homemade cards that do not sufficiently resemble the ACBL convention card, are not acceptable substitutes.
- Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards of a partnership must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the Standard American Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6 board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.

The objective of these warnings and penalties is the encouragement of full compliance with ACBL regulations.



No culture shock for Goddess of the Sword

It has been more than a decade since a wideeyed young woman from Iceland arrived in the United States with one purpose – to play bridge.

Hjordis Eythorsdottir – known to friends as Disa – is older and wiser now, but her focus is the same. She now earns her living playing the game. As long as the milieu is a bridge table and good competition, she will feel at home.

Eythorsdottir – whose first name translates to Goddess of the Sword – was "discovered" by the late Ron Andersen, who regularly did vugraph shows at European and World Bridge Federation tournaments. Eythorsdottir was a member of the Iceland women's team and was well known across the Atlantic.

In her words, Andersen "imported" her to the U.S.

She made a splash almost immediately upon arriving. At her first NABC, in Cincinnati in 1994, she was a member of the winning squad in the national Women's Swiss Teams. She has won several North American championships since then and she is always high on the list of Barry Crane Top 500 contenders.

Interestingly, Andersen had recruited Eythorsdottir to play with him in an effort to help the late Richard Hunt win the Top 500 in 1994. Hunt's main rival that year was the late Bob Glenn, and one of his supporters was Curtis Cheek, now Eythorsdottir's husband.

"We played against each other all year," she says.

All of 1994, says Eythorsdottir, remains a blur. "I came in February and had two or three weeks off for the rest of the year," she recalls.

Ten years ago this August, Cheek and Eythorsdottir were married in Huntsville AL, where they still live. They are on the road a lot going to bridge tournaments, but the game is still their passion despite the fact that it's a job as well.

"I'm enjoying it more than ever," she says. "There's always something new, and you learn something every day."

Eythorsdottir has been playing with George Rosenkranz at the Spring NABC. "It's fun to play with him because he is intensely competitive," she says

In June, she will travel to Tenerife, Canary Islands, for the 2nd European Open Championship, where she has a date to play with Jeff Meckstroth in the Mixed Pairs. She says Meckstroth has had a big influence on her and on Cheek. "He's our bridge guru," Eythorsdottir says.
