Second time the charm for LM Open champs

Ron Smith of Chattanooga and Walter Schafer Jr., who played together only once previously, stormed to a huge lead after the first final session of the Life Master Open Pairs to win handily despite a mediocre final session.

At the three-quarter mark, Schafer and Smith were 174.4 matchpoints ahead of second place. Their final score was 2525.73. Runnersup, with 2498.45, were Michael Schreiber of Los Angeles and Curtis Cheek of Huntsville AL.

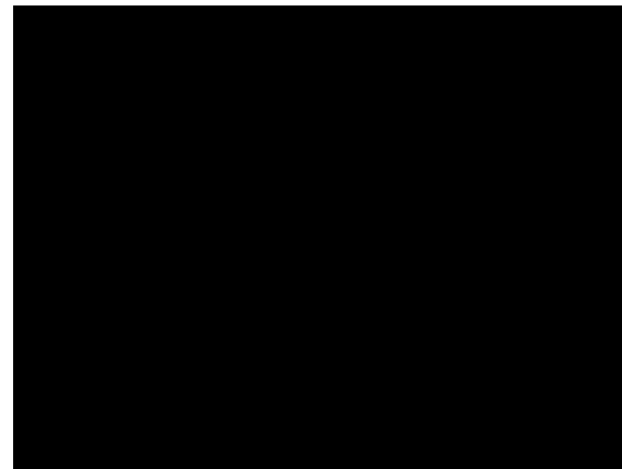
Schafer, of Bloomingdale IL, and Smith played together for the first time as a last-minute partnership in the Open Swiss Teams at the Spring NABC in Philadelphia. Playing with Marshall Miles and David Sacks, they came in third.

Leaving nothing to chance this time, Schafer and Smith -- who stood seventh after two qualifying sessions -- posted a 67.33% game in the first final set to lead by more than two boards. Their 51.99% game in the second final session was more than enough for the win.

The victory was the second North American championship for each player. Schafer and Tom Fox won the IMP Pairs at the 1994 Summer NABC in San Diego. Smith was a member of the winning squad in the Men's Board-a-Match Teams in 1977.

That victory was one of the most unusual in the history of ACBL tournaments. Smith, the late Lou Bluhm and Richard Doughty were set up to play with Sidney Lazard as a four-man team.

Lazard, however, became ill during the first session and eventually was unable to play. Three differ-

ent players filled in for Lazard over the four-session event and somehow the team scrambled in with a victory. In the *Official Encyclopedia of Bridge*, seven players are credited with the win.

Smith, a math professor at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga, said he and Schafer took advantage of a lot of luck during their run to the title. "I don't think I've ever been dealt bigger games in three straight sessions," he said. "We whittled two of them down, but not the third."

After he and Smith mounted their huge halftime lead on Saturday, a confident Schafer suggested to Smith that he might want to change shirts to have his photo taken that evening.

"I'm not having a 67% game," said Smith, "and changing shirts."

Saito, Kondo win Non-LM Pairs

Yoko Saito of Kanagawa, Japan, and Michiko Kondo of New York edged out two players from California to earn the championship in the Non-Life Master Pairs.

Saito and Kondo declined to be interviewed or photographed.

Their final score of 353.45 was good enough to best Anthony Hurwitz of Los Angeles and Adam Barron of Beverly Hills, runnersup with 352.57.

Barron, a physician doing residency at West Los Angeles Veterans Hospital, is studying pathology. Hurwitz is a CPA who works for a small accounting firm in Brentwood.

The pair, who have playing together about two years, earned their first gold points in the Non-LM Pairs.

They were introduced by a mutual friend and hit it off immediately as bridge partners and as friends.

Although slightly disappointed to miss first place by less than one matchpoint, the two were delighted to have done as well as they did. "I'm thrilled," said Hurwitz.

Burger-Sion triumph in LM Women's Pairs

Suzy Burger of West Bloomfield MI and Barbara Sion of Las Vegas had very fine sessions when it counted most -- in the final two sessions of the Life Master Women's Pairs. They now reign as champions after outdistancing runnersup Linda Lewis of Las Vegas and Judy Randel of Albuquerque by 18 matchpoints on a 25 top. Another three points further back in third place were Susan Evans of Sacramento CA and Shirley Blum of Fresno CA.

Burger and Sion have been playing as a partnership for only two years -- and only at NABCs. Their basic system is two-over-one game forcing. "We are very forgiving," said Burger, "and that always helps when you're in competition like this. We try not to let bad boards bother us."

This was Sion's third North American triumph -- she won the Mixed Teams twice. Burger's previous win was in the Women's Board-a-Match Teams.

Both winners got started in duplicate in unusual ways.

Burger, who played a lot of bridge in college, wasn't having as much luck finding a game when she got out into the business world. So she did what that famous telephone company says to do -- she looked up Bridge Clubs in the yellow pages. Later she met Chuck at the bridge table and now they're married. Chuck, like Suzy, is a big winner at bridge.

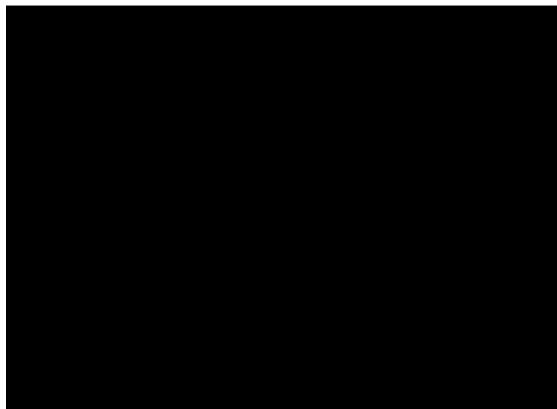
Sion was approached by a woman in her office one day who asked if she played duplicate. "Duplicate? What's that?" was the response. When she heard what it was all about, she decided to try it. She played with Betty Perkins in Atlanta, had average the first time and was the winner the second time. "I was hooked then," said Sion.

A big bridge day

Yesterday was a big bridge day -- 1656 tables were in play. The afternoon session drew 792 tables -- even the morning was huge with 96.

The total to date is 3260.5 tables, well ahead of 1990 San Francisco, which had 2853 at this point.

The novice turnout has been exceptional. Twenty-eight teams showed up for the morning novice Swiss. There were 96 tables of novices at the afternoon session.

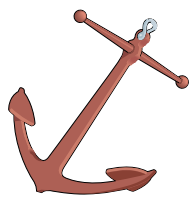

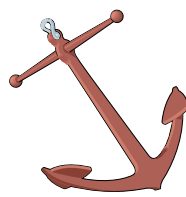

Second thoughts

Jan Martel found herself caught in a stepping-stone squeeze on this deal from the first final session of the Life Master Open Pairs.

Chip led his lowest heart, and the 7 forced the queen. Zia had nine tricks at this point, but no way to take them -- he couldn't get back to his ♦A. He began by leading out dummy's clubs, and both Chip and Jan had to find lots of pitches. Chip knew he had to save his two hearts, so he discarded two spades and a diamond. Jan meanwhile was in terrible trouble. She had to save two diamonds, so she had to pitch two hearts.

Zia cashed the ♦K, then led a spade. After winning the ace, Jan was able to lead a heart to partner's ace and win the heart return and another heart. But then she was forced to lead her diamond to Zia's ace for his ninth trick.

As Chip was telling us about this hand, he had a sudden second thought. "I could have saved us on this hand," he said. "I'm the one that had to protect the diamonds. I have to keep both diamonds and throw away spades. Then Jan can sluff all of her diamonds and hold onto hearts. Declarer can't overtake the ♦K because I have still have two diamonds. So when he leads a spade, Jan wins and leads a heart to my ace. I fire back my last heart and Jan takes three more for down one."

Mark Feldman wound up in 4♠ on this deal.

The opening diamond lead went to the king, and Feldman tried a trump. East led a heart to partner's ace, and Feldman won the continuation. He cashed one high club and led a trump to his queen. Then he switched back to clubs. West was able to ruff the fourth round of the suit, but he was through at this point. If he returned a diamond, Feldman could win, finesse in trumps, draw the last trump and cash the good club. If he returned a trump, Feldman would win, cash the high trump and run two good clubs. And if he led his last heart, Feldman would pitch a club from hand as he ruffed in dummy, then pitch the last club on the ♦A. Then he would lead a diamond and West would be trump coupé.

The two U.S. teams -- plus two from Canada -- were chosen in team trials during the Summer NABC in Miami Beach last summer.

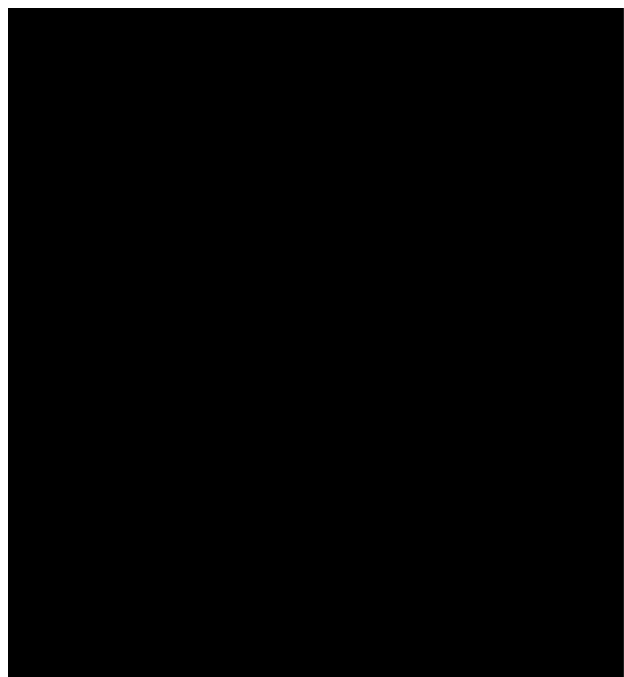
Canada Team I is David Levy, Jeffery Blond, Eric Sutherland, Mike Roberts, Darren Wolpert and Frederic Pollack.

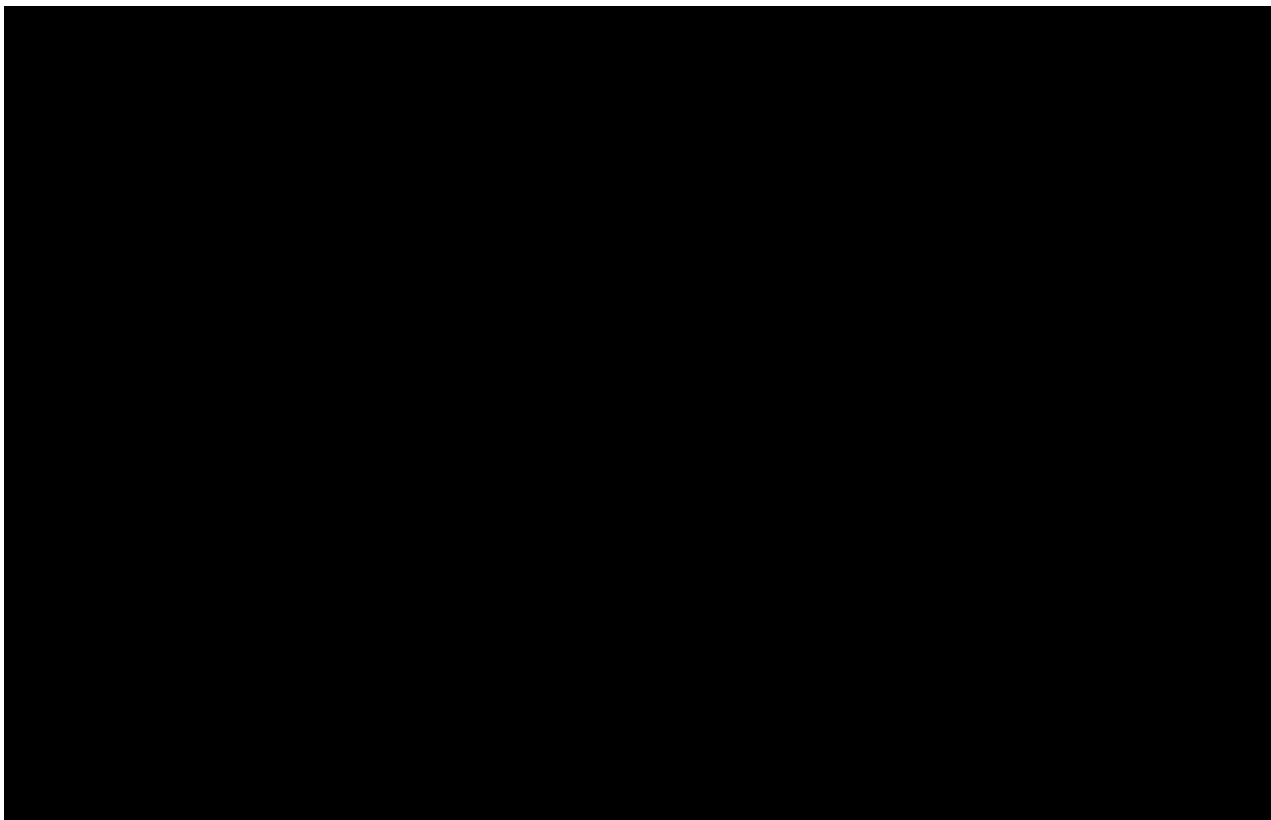

German goal: promote bridge among the young

While the ACBL wrestles with challenges attendant to attracting new blood to the game, the leaders in the struggle can at least take heart that they aren't the only ones in that situation.

The German Bridge Federation, for example, has embarked on a series of new programs aimed at attracting more young people to the game.

So says Rolf Kühn, a member of the German Bridge Federation's Junior Committee. Kühn, visiting San Francisco on business, dropped by the reception for Junior players at the Marriott Saturday.

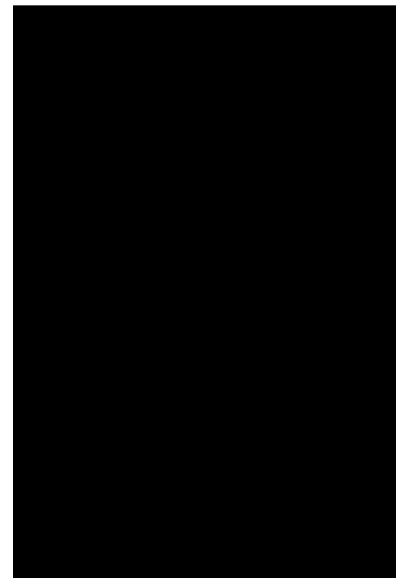
Kühn, 27, said the GBF is busy organizing tournaments and bridge camps for Juniors and preparing to make a pitch to schools to introduce bridge to youngsters in a program similar to the ACBL's highly successful *School Bridge Lesson Series*.

The goal, Kühn said, is to increase awareness of bridge among young people. "Right now," Kühn said, "they don't know what bridge is. If you ask a German youth about bridge he will tell you it is a game played by British ladies while they drink tea."

The German Bridge Federation is also preparing to introduce young people to the game via Mini-Bridge games -- similar to ACBL's Bridge Plus+. Mini-Bridge has proven to be successful in France, Kühn said.

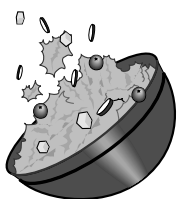
Also in the works, he said, is the promotion of a new bidding system, one similar to Standard American, with a five-card major base. It would replace the current system, which is a conglomeration of various European systems, with strong influence by British and French methods.

The various programs, Kühn said, may not produce immediate growth in membership for the GBF, but they will represent a healthy step in the right direction. "At least," he said, "young people will know what bridge is."

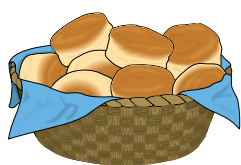

Wei-Sender team seeks to defend Women's BAM

Kathie Wei-Sender, playing with two new teammates, will lead her quintet in quest of a repeat in the Women's Board-a-Match Teams, a four-session event beginning today.

Wei-Sender, Lynn Deas, Beth Palmer, Carol Sanders and Betty Ann Kennedy staged a final-round rally last year in Atlanta to win the event by .61 points.

The team this year is made up of Wei-Sender, Deas, Palmer, Juanita Chambers and Sue Sachs.

The contestants will be playing for the Coffin Trophy, one of the oldest and most historic trophies in play in NABC competition.

For years there was only one "National" Women's Team championship -- and that was a Board-a-Match event.

Donated by Charles Emmet Coffin in 1933, the trophy was contested at the "Winter Nationals" in the days when there were only two NABC championships -- Summer and Winter. In 1963 the event was moved to the new Spring NABC, where it was in play until the format was changed to knockout teams in 1976.

For the next decade, there was no national Women's Board-a-Match team championship. Swiss Teams had become popular and a Women's Swiss with NABC rating was established in the early Eighties. But board-a-match play for women was not dead -- it was just in hiatus for a few years.

The Coffin Trophy was revived at the Fall NABC in Atlanta in 1986, and new life was breathed into women's board-a-match play.

Many experts consider board-a-match the most exacting form of the game. Equal weight is accorded each deal and every trick is important in board-a-match play, where scoring is board-by-board.

1976 -- It is interesting to note that the first winners of the NABC Women's Knockout Teams was the same sextet that won the Board-a-Match event in 1974 and 1975 -- Farell, Hawes, Johnson, Mitchell, Moss and Truscott.

Jones died of complications due to AIDS on Feb. 8 of this year.

Jabbour, Arnold seek Third Senior KO win

When play begins in the Senior Knockout Teams today, Zeke Jabbour and Russ Arnold will be aiming for their third consecutive win in the event, limited to players 55 and older.

The Florida men -- Jabbour lives in Boca Raton, Arnold in Miami --teamed with Richard Hunt, Las Vegas; Dan Morse, Houston; Chuck Said, Nashville, and John Sutherlin, Dallas, to win the inaugural event at the Fall NABC in Minneapolis in 1994.

Their team in last year's Senior KO win was Mike Levine, Ann Arbor MI and Boca Raton FL; Billy Eisenberg, also Boca Raton; Benito Garozzo, Palm Beach FL, and Tommy Sanders, Nashville.

At the World Bridge Championships in Albuquerque in 1994, the same team -- with Fred Hamilton playing instead of Garozzo -- placed second in the Senior Swiss Teams.

"It's a good team," said Jabbour. "We might win anything, including a world championship."

This year's squad includes Jabbour, Arnold, Sanders, Eisenberg -- plus Mary Chilcote, Cleveland, and Hamilton.

Winners of the Senior KO will have their names engraved on the trophy presented by the U. S. Playing Card Co.

Open Board-a-Match Teams compete for Mitchell trophy

Competition for the Victor Mitchell Trophy, awarded to the winners of the Open Board-a-Match Teams, will begin today. The trophy honors one of bridge's most colorful characters -- a champion player, philosopher, mentor to the stars -- and a member of the Bridge Hall of Fame.

"For more than 30 years," said Ron Andersen in 1994, "Vic has been the experts' mentor from coast to coast. His unknown contributions to the world of tournament bridge are far greater than those of better known people."

Mitchell, a Grand Life Master with more than 10,000 masterpoints, won five North American championships including the Spingold in 1956 and 1959, the Life Master Men's Pairs in 1962 and the Men's Teams in 1962 and 1963.

He represented the United States in international competition several times. His best finishes were second in the 1964 World Team Olympiad and runnerup in the World Mixed Teams, playing with his wife Jacqui, Sam and Tubby Stayman and Jimmy Cayne.

Mitchell didn't play much in his later years but he was usually on hand at NABCs to see his friends and give advice.

Mitchell claimed that he never played bridge for glory or prestige. "The people," he said, "are more important than the bridge. I've met some of the most fantastic people playing bridge. I've had a ball."

The game

The Open Board-a-Match Teams is a four-session event which consists of two qualifying and two final sessions. It was a men's event until 1990 when it became an open event.

Koshy won the opening heart lead with the 10 and led a club. West perforce took his ace and persisted with a second heart, won with the 8 in dummy. Koshy overtook the ♥K (East discarding a spade) to lead the ♠10, which held. He cashed the good heart, and East parted with another spade as Koshy ditched a diamond from dummy. Next came the ♠Q, which also held.

Koshy then got out of his hand with a club, and East returned a low diamond after winning the jack. West won with the queen when Koshy played low, and West put Koshy in dummy with the ♠A. Koshy threw the ♦K on this trick!

He then led the ♦J, and East found himself endplayed. He won the ace, but then had to lead away from his ♣Q-7.

When asked why he threw away the ♦K, Koshy laughed. "It was a worthless card. If West had the ace, then he would cash a good spade to set the contract. If East had the ace, he was going to be endplayed in clubs."

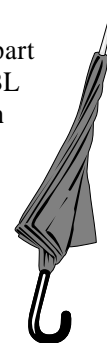
